### Regulations On Ice-Fishing Shacks Will Be Strictly Enforced At Lake

The newly organized Borough of Harveys Lake is taking legal measures to abate a long standing nuisance.

For years, ice fishermen have left their litter on the ice, to sink to the bottom of the lake after the ice melts in the spring. It has been an unsightly mess toward the end of the season, when debris has had a chance to accumulate.

Under recently published ordinances, there will be a fine for such misuse of the ice. Anglers will keep their shacks in good condition, or else.

No more cardboard shelters. The shack must be made of durable material, capable of withstanding wind and weather.

And each shack must be registered with the Borough secretary, a number obtained, and the number prominently displayed on the side of the shack. The deposit will be returned at the end of the season, after inspection has shown that the premises are in good condition, the shack removed, and the litter cared for.

When the shack is removed, the numeral is to be returned to the secretary.


