

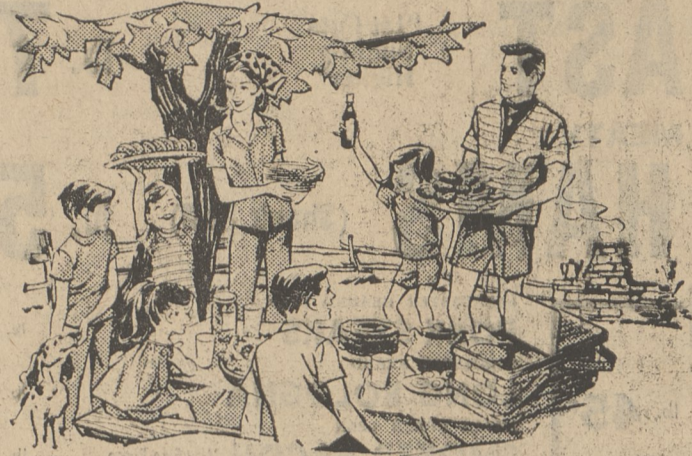

This is an open installation and relatives and friends are cordially invited to attend.

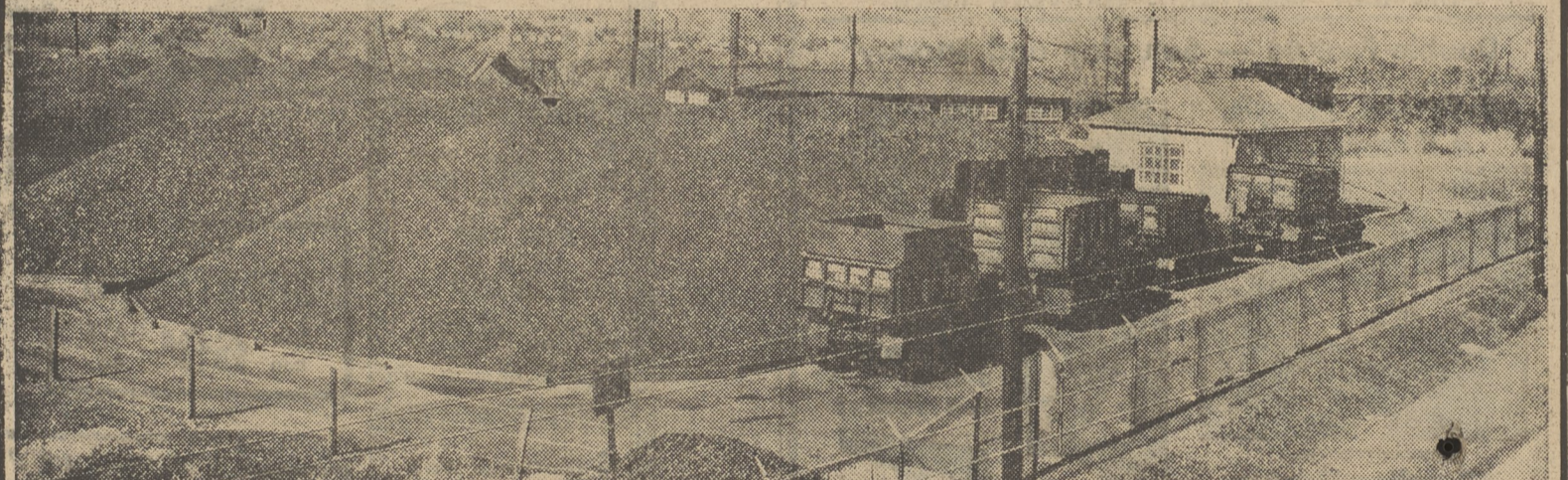
