## Ant Hills And Elephants, Gardenias And Jasmine, Part Of African Scene

Nancy Elston Schimmell writes entertaining letters from the mission field in West Africa. The Dallas Post is privileged to share in the letters. Mrs. Clarence Elston, Nancy's mother, recently sent us typed excerpts from communications from Liberia, near the Guinea border, in the bush.  
Nancy writes:  
We have had guest pastors for several Sundays. Last Sunday the pastor, his wife and three boys ate dinner with us. Then George and I went to Salayea Town to teach Sunday School. The children do not come until we ring the bell. George preached the sermon at the morning service the week before.  
Am anxious to see what letters you sent to the Dallas Post. Glad you shared them with others. We receive our paper about two months late and really enjoy the Dallas Post.  
On Saturday I walked with James (our houseboy) to his village, Ghoiyeta. It took almost two hours. James pointed out things along the way which made the walk more interesting. One object, a large black ant hill which some people worship. We saw a tree that was full of bees. A slash had been made in a small tree close to the bee tree and a bunch of leaves stuck there. This indicated that someone had found the nest and was claiming it as his own. No one will bother it now. I saw how people build fences around their farms for protection and also build animal traps into the fences to catch any animal that gets inside the fence.  
There are not many flowers in the bush, but we did see one very beautiful type of flower. It grows close to the ground with a flower head about the size of a chrysanthemum, the color is somewhere between orange and red.  
All the people in the village were happy to see us. We visited in several huts including James' mother and stepfather. We walked to the water where the women wash clothes, then to a large pit where they beat the palm nuts to make palm oil. Everywhere I walked the children followed, sitting or standing as close as possible. James picked oranges for us to take back, and his mother and father gave me a large bag of rice.  
The people had a small Church in town. They belong to the Salayea Parish. However they have an evangelist who preaches in their church. The town people were extremely proud of their Church.  
It is time for chapel now and after that I will begin working.
