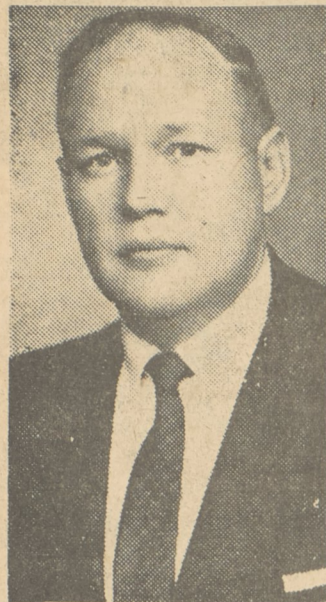
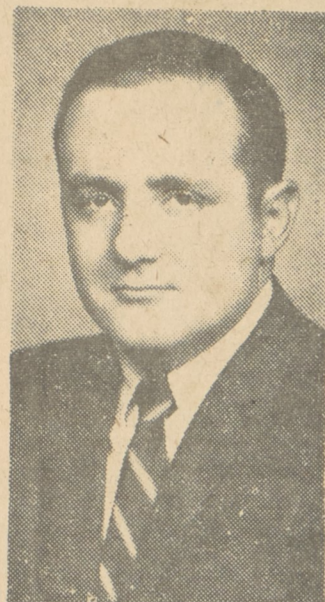


## Commonwealth appoints two
