

Child Welfare staffer awarded State grant

Elizabeth Ann DeCesaris, Shavertown, has been awarded a grant by Pennsylvania's Professional Education Program for further study at the new school of social work, Marywood College.

Miss DeCesaris, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph DeCesaris, is a staff member of the Child Welfare Services, Luzerne County Institution District and will pursue studies at Marywood for her master's degree in social work. She is the first employee from the services to study at the new school.

The Education Plan will enable Miss DeCesaris to receive a salary during her training.

A graduate of Naticoke High School, Miss DeCesaris received her certificate as a registered nurse after training at Mercy Hospital, Wilkes-Barre. She earned her bachelor of science degree in nursing from Catholic University, Washington, D.C. in 1955.

She became a caseworker at the Child Welfare Services of the Luzerne County Institution District in 1959 and has

been transferred to the state program while pursuing her studies in social work at Marywood's new school.

Miss DeCesaris also has the unique distinction of participating in the Marywood school of social work's innovative approach to social work education.

Students and field instruction personnel will work with regional social agencies, and business and industry in a modular system of education.
