An art exhibit at the Conyngham Gallery, Wilkes College, will be shown May 17 to 23, at the college campus, Wilkes-Barre.

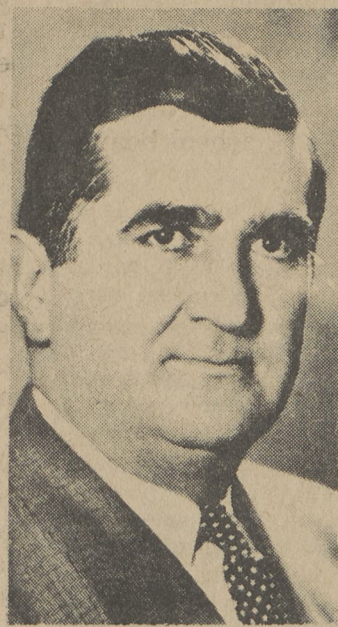
**GARDEN CLUB**

### NNI retains new circulation mgr.

Philip Fitelson, Mountaintop, has been appointed assistant to the publisher of Northeastern Newspapers Inc., it was announced this week by Henry H. Null 4th, publisher. Mr. Fitelson has wide experience in the circulation and promotion departments of daily newspapers.

He was with The New York Herald Tribune's circulation department for 18 years where he was a traveling representative in charge of a 22-state area. He also was a circulation representative with The Jersey Journal, Jersey City, N.J., The Hudson Dispatch, Hudson, N.Y.; The Yonkers Herald (now the Herald-Statesman), Yonkers, N.Y., and The Omaha World Herald, Omaha, Neb.

Mr. Fitelson, who retired from newspapers and is now coming back to them, has an award from American Airlines for being the first circulation man to deliver newspapers by airplane. He was with The New York Herald Tribune at that time, 1922.

At present Mr. Fitelson is in the real estate business as a licensed real estate broker and

appraiser in three states, Pennsylvania, New York and New Jersey. His offices are at Mountaintop.

In 1959 Mr. Fitelson was elected school director for the Central Luzerne County School District. He served as president and director of the Retreat State Hospital board of trustees. He was on the Committee of Humanities appointed by Gov. William W. Scranton.

Mr. Fitelson will keep an office at Northeastern Newspapers Inc., 41 Lehman Ave., Dallas.

### Regional Concert to be held


