LEROY K. HONEYWELL

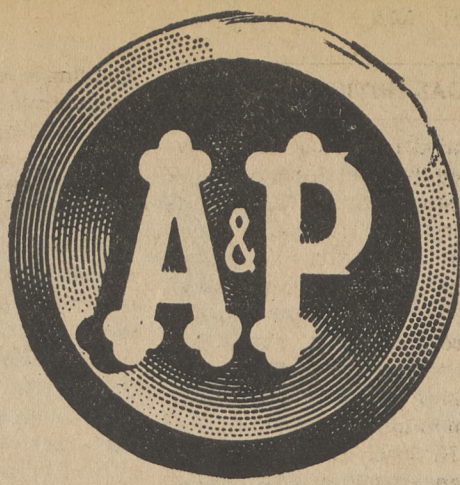
