

# Gate of Heaven acquires Dallas home for convent

Gate of Heaven Church has purchased the former Asa Day home situated on Terrace Drive, Dallas, to use as a convent for the nuns who teach in the nearby parish school. The purchase has received the approval of Bishop McCormick, head of the Scranton Diocese, and of Mother William Joseph, provincial of the Mercy Order. Msgr. Francis A. Kane, pastor of the church, stated that some renovations will be necessary in order to make the home suitable to house the nine nuns on the school faculty. The sisters have been living at College Misericordia since 1951 when Gate of Heaven School opened.

According to Msgr. Kane, a chapel and a community room will be located on the first floor of the convent as well as a kitchen and dining room. Separate living quarters will be provided for each of the nine nuns by using the five rooms on the second level of the house and connecting them with the upper level of the garage where renovations will provide four more rooms.

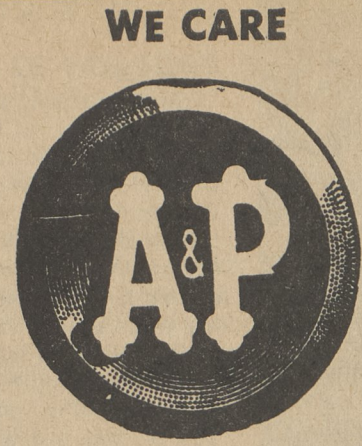
