problems are included among calls the referral service has answered.

One of the far-reaching effects of Call For Action, the chairman predicts, will be that government planning agencies will soon know where there is a lack of help for troubled persons.

"We already know from the calls that have come in to us that while there is an agency which deals with the problem of child abuse, there is no group or agency to handle the problem of abuse or neglect of the aged," the chairman stated. "We have discovered a number of older people in this area who have been left to shift for themselves, completely without the help of family or friends."




