

# Dallas cagers go down three times

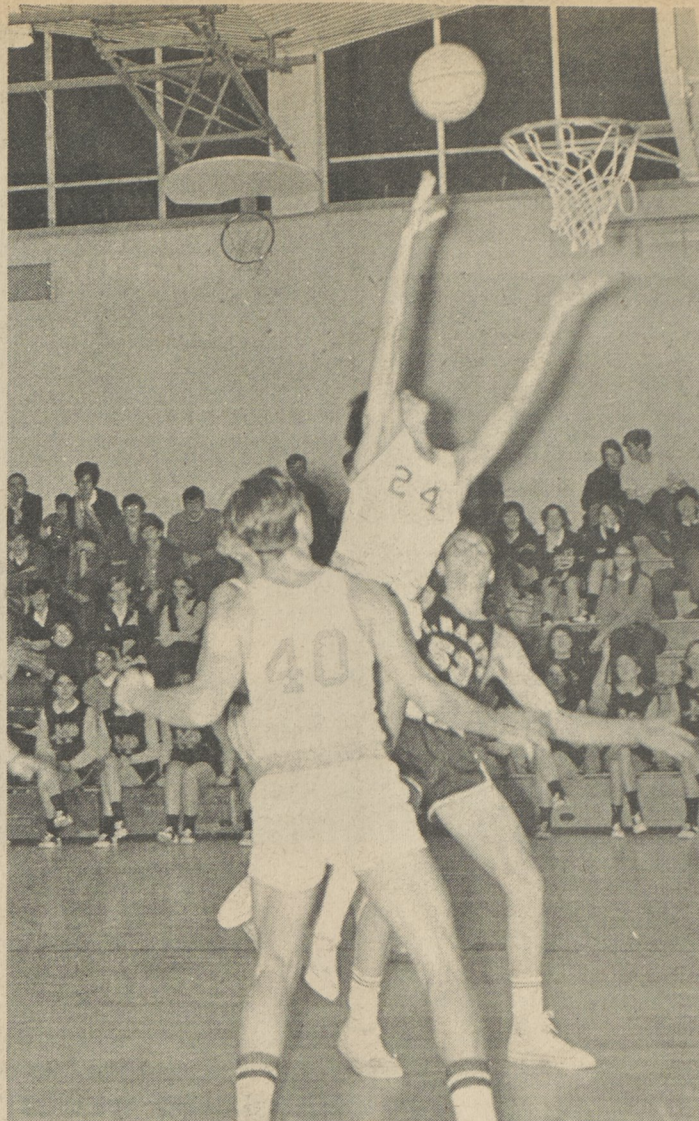
