

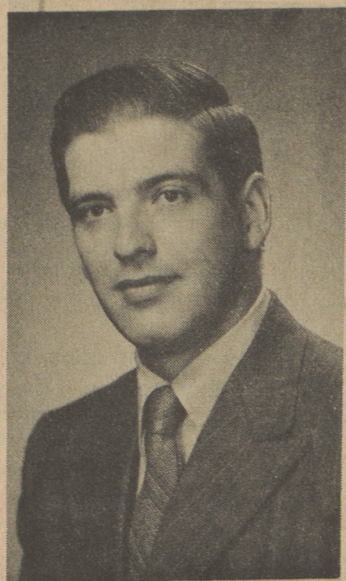
# 9 Teachers Join Faculty in Dallas District

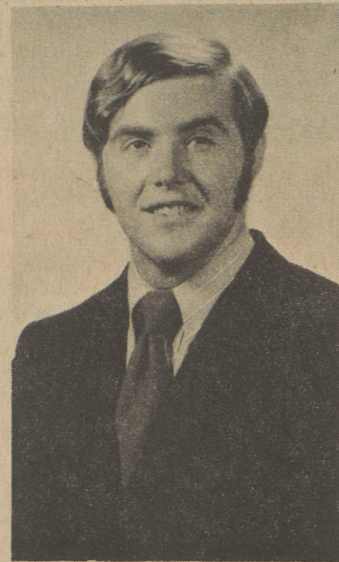

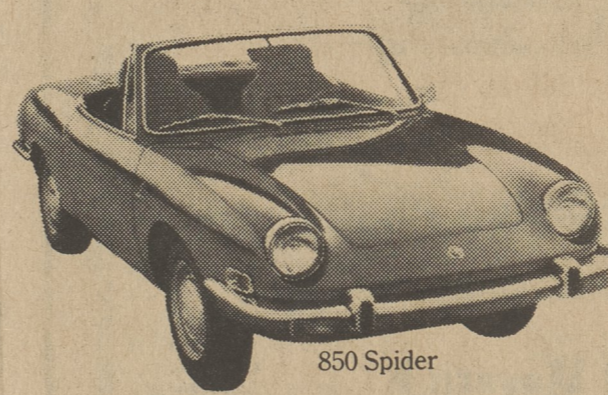

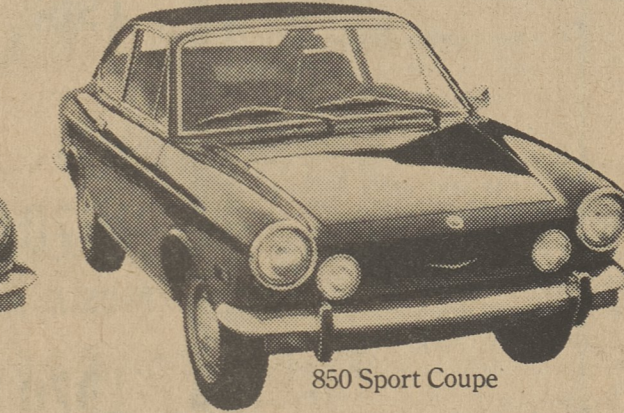
