Wilkes Offers Curriculum Leading to M.A. in Business

The Graduate Division of Wilkes College is offering a curriculum leading to the Master's Degree in business administration, according to Ralph B. Rozelle, director of graduate studies.

The purposes of the program are to develop professional managers with emphasis on the foundation, organization, operation, and control of business enterprises; to develop individuals trained in research and constructive business leadership; to enable individuals to create and evaluate alternative courses of action as a procedure for making decisions.

Designed to provide business education at the master's level, the program is not only for

those who have had undergraduate training in business and economics, but also for interested engineers, scientists, social scientists and others who have a minimum amount of background education in business and economics.

For those with background deficiencies, pre-seminar courses are offered. These are intended to provide the necessary background, and also act as refresher courses for those who have been away from formal course work for a number of years.

The program is structured for the convenience of the student. Courses are offered in the evening, for the convenience of those who are presently engaged in business, government or professions.

Lake-Lehman Junior High Initiates Pilot Program

A pilot program will be initiated this year in the Lake-Lehman Junior High School, with concentration on industrial arts, music, home economics, science and geography.

In the past, art and music were offered one period per week for 36 weeks; science and geography were offered for a half year in grades 7 and 8, and home economics and industrial arts were given for two periods a week.

Under the new program, three periods of art will be made available to all seventh grade students; three periods of music to all eighth graders; a full year of science in the seventh grade; and a full year of geography in the eighth grade. For the boys in the seventh grade, a full year of industrial arts will be offered; for the girls, a full year of home economics.

It is planned that the same areas of work will be covered but the concentration will allow for better articulation. Seventh grade students will be in class for 34 periods out of a 40 period week, and if they successfully complete all their subjects, will have earned 6.8 credits.

Eighth grade students will be in class for 31 periods and will earn 6.2 credits; ninth graders will be in class for 32 periods per week and will earn 6.4 credits.

Students in the junior high school who elect band will increase their class load by three and increase their credits earned by .6.

Reading Program
The reading program is another type of concentrated program which has been used in past years with success.

The E.S.E.A. Title I Program (reading improvement with supportive services) has been approved for the 1971 school year. The reading program will begin with grades one through nine.

The following teachers will assist in the program: Margaret Toluba, Lake-Lehman High School, grades 7,

8, 9; Linda Baker, Lehman-Jackson Elementary, grades 1-6; Gerilyn Pawloski, Ross and Lake Elementary, grades 1-6; Margaret Thomas, Noxen Elementary, grades 1-6. Supporting services will be performed by Michael Toole, home and school visitor, and Maryann Blessner, guidance counselor. The regular school program will be supplemented next summer with a five-or-six-weeks summer school program.
