18-Year Olds Must Register with Service

Young men reaching 18 years of age must still register under the Military Selective Service Act even though no one is presently being inducted. Local Board 98, Wilkes-Barre has jurisdiction over Luzerne county. Registration can be accomplished by one of several means available: Report to the local board office at IBE Building, Room 1020, 69 Public Square, Wilkes-Barre, high school students may report to a Registrar at their school; or by use of the Mailer Registration Card which has been placed in many of the local post offices or the Pennsylvania National Guard Armories. If any of these means are inconvenient he may contact the local board office and request a Mailer Registration Card be sent to him. Young men should register during the 60 day period commencing 30 days prior to their 18th birthday.
