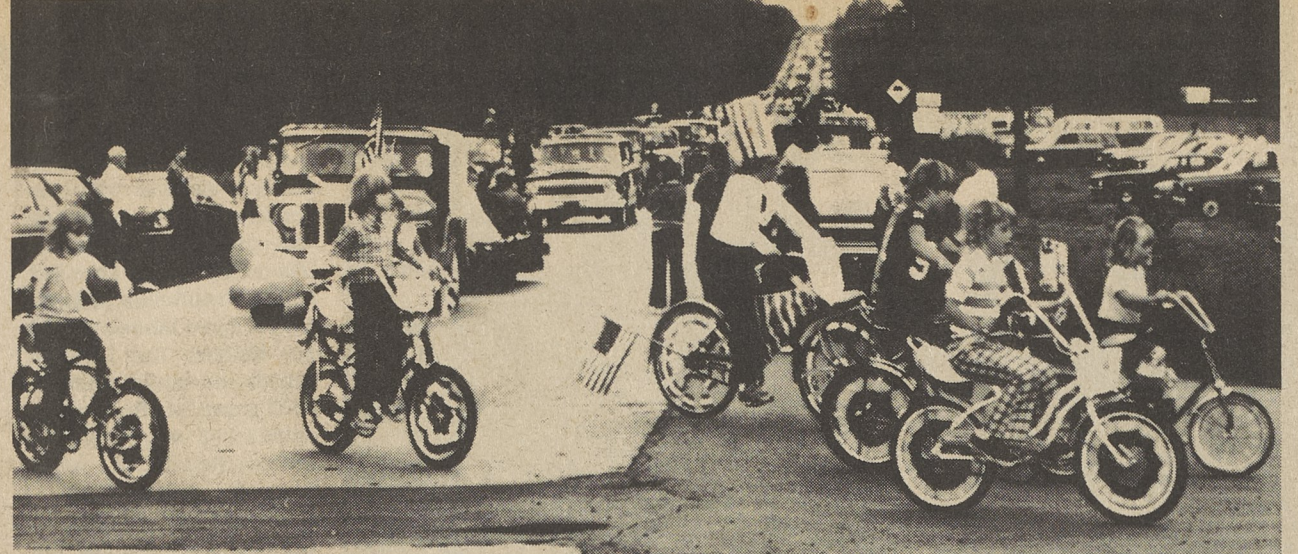


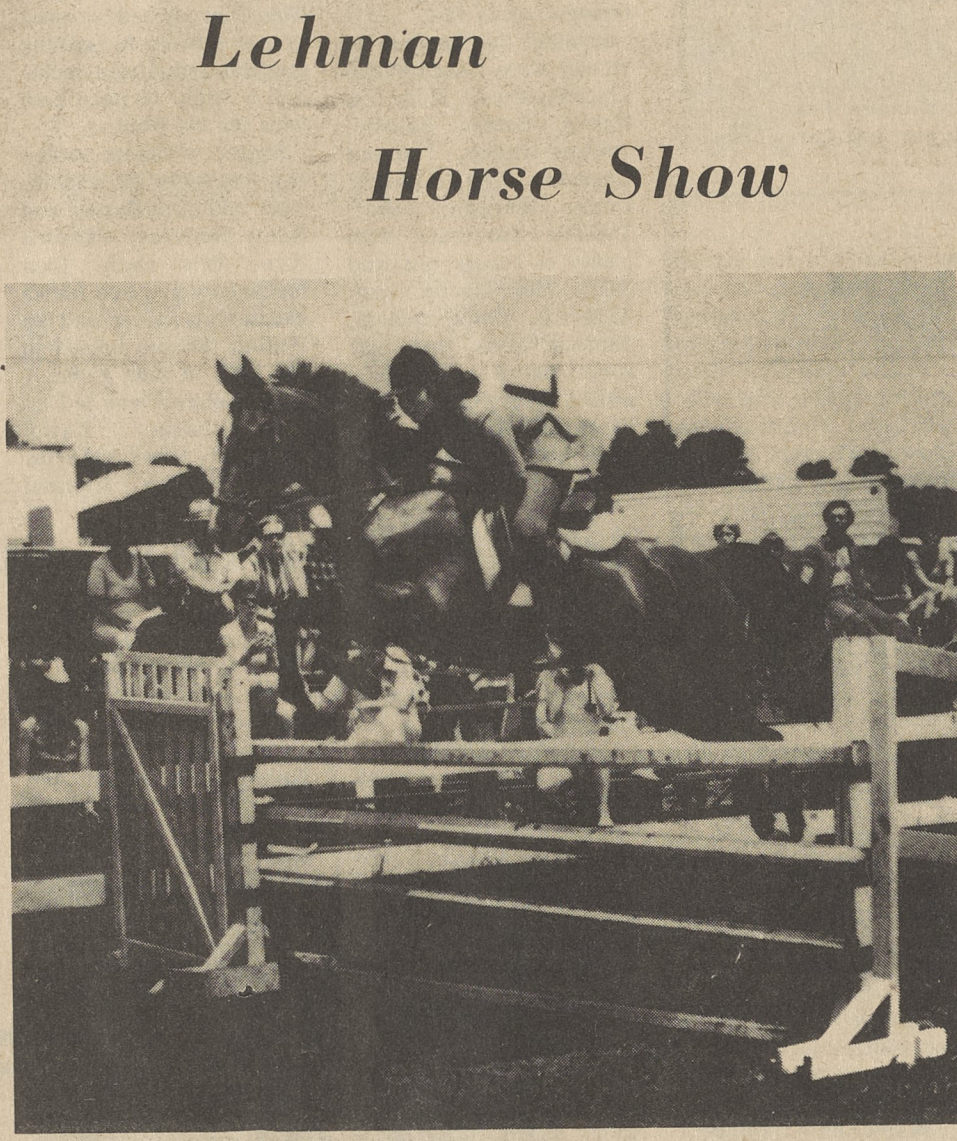
LAKE-LEHMAN BAND—Lake-Lehman band led the opening day parade of the Lehman Horse Show held at the horse show grounds last weekend.



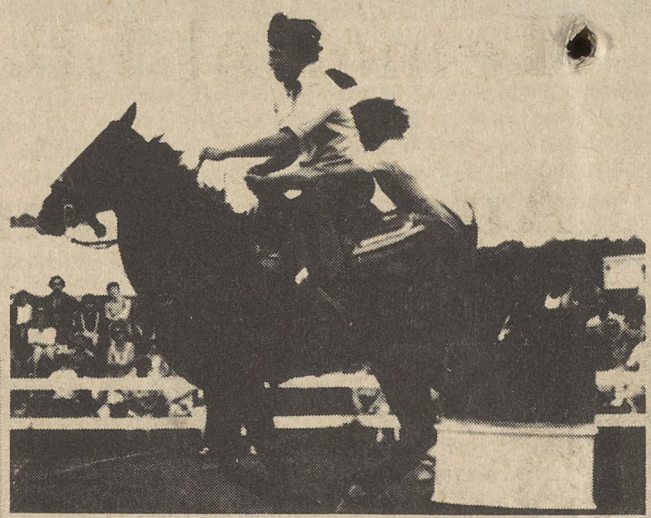
