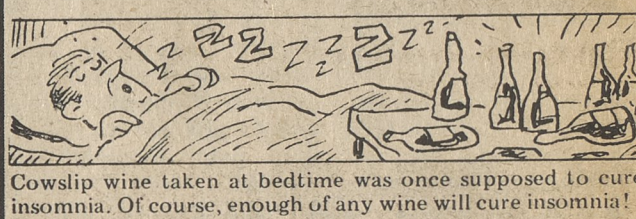
This is the official state finals to the Miss National Teenager Pageant to be held in Atlanta, Georgia in
