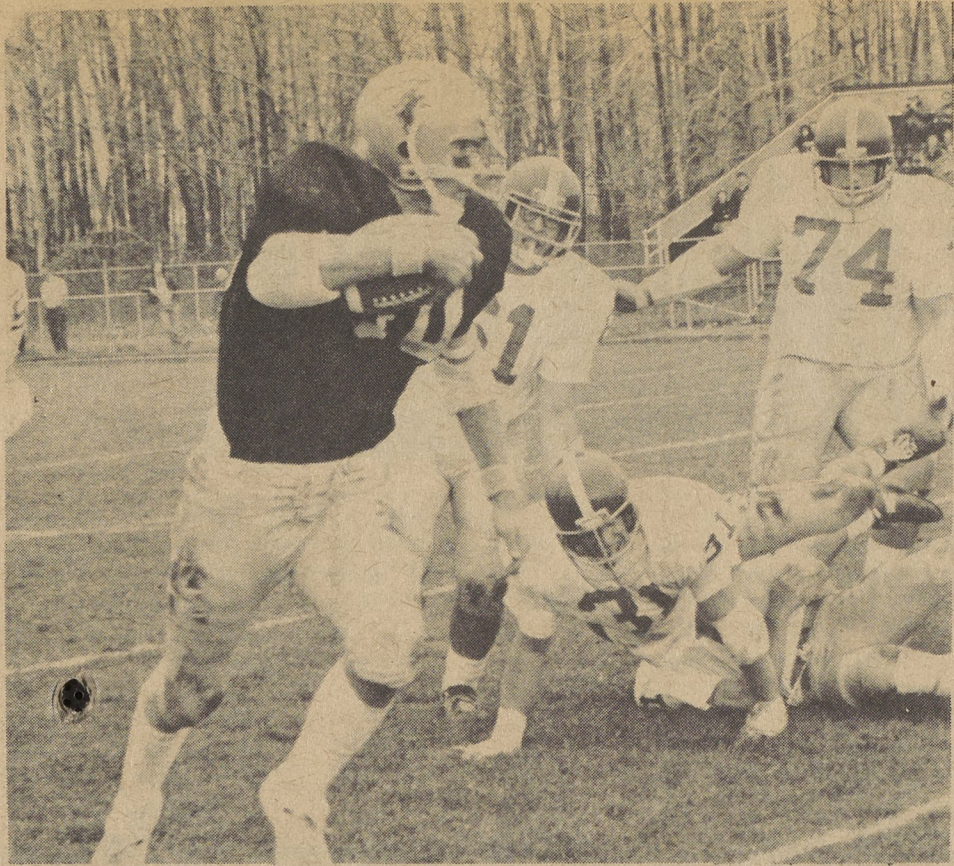

L-L beats Hanover, 14-0

Can Coughlin intimidate Knights?

Will Coughlin size intimidate the Black Knights of Lake-Lehman High School?

That's the big question in Coach Rich Gorgone's mind these days. His Knights, nobody's doormat, have done more than hold their own with schools their own size and they've succeeded in putting a scare into Class A

contenders the size of Meyers and Nanticoke. "We can give them a run for their money," the coach acknowledged, observing along the way that he felt it was time the class B Knights to upset one of the A powers.

The Black Knights blasted Hanover 14-0, relying as usual on their strong defense and the offense collaboration of Quarterback Chirs Yanchik and Running Backs Mark DeCesaris and Mark Kalish.

"I got a little conservative in the second half," Gorgone said. The Knights got off to a 14-0 halftime lead and maintained it through the remainder of the game.

Both Knight touchdowns came in the second period, the first, both on Chris Yanchik passes. The first came to Tom Snell, on a 27-yarder which Craig Yanchik followed with a

successful point-after kick. The second touchdown came when Chris Yanchik connected with Mark Kalish and gained a 23-yard score. Craig Yanchik again split the uprights for the point after.

"It was a nice TD to Snell on a post pattern," Gorgone said. "(Chris) Yanchik ran the team well. He pitched the option well and ran the offense well." But Gorgone's main enthusiasm after the Hanover game was for the defense. "We're fourth in the Valley now," he noted. "We played great D, held them to about 80 yards total."

Gorgone was impressed with the effort of his secondary and applauded the efforts of Mark DeCesaris and Jackie Zaleskas. He said Snell, who intercepted another pass, "could have had two more." He said Snell had about 10 interceptions so far this year. Middle Linebacker George Nemetz also had a chance two interceptions the coach said. "We closed off their pass offense, Hanover hit only five of 19."

"They (Hanover) had a pretty good defensive scheme against us."

The other key people offensively for Lake-Lehman? Gorgone singled out Center Rich Perrego and Dave Mahle. "Perrego played a nice game at
