

Dallas gains win over Hanover

Double wins by Chuck Riegel, Bill Kleiner, John Majewski and Don Bolton led Coach Clint Brobst's Dallas cinderman to a 92-58 win over Hanover last Thursday at the Back Mountain track. Majewski exerted no effort to take the high jump with 5'8" and the triple jump with a distance of 43'8".
