

Back Mt. Jay-C-Ettes mark first anniversary with installation

At a special meeting Tuesday at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Shavertown, the Back Mountain Jay-C-Ettes celebrated their first anniversary with the installation of their new board of directors by outgoing president, Glenda Pomrinke.

Assuming office for the coming fiscal year were Helen Stager, president; Maryann Popielarz, vice-president; Debby Bayer,

secretary; Charlotte Farley, treasurer; and Glenda Pomrinke, Carolyn Bulford, Carol Chapple, Sandy Mannear, and Lois Townsend, advisors.

Special words of reflection were offered by Mrs. Pomrinke, whose leadership has guided the Jay-C-Ettes to their present standing in the community.

The evening's activities, arranged by the internal

programs committee (Debby Bayer, Shirley Kishbaugh, and Maryann Popielarz) featured a reminiscence of the group's history by Danny Kelley, one of the original members.

The Jay-C-Ettes were formed in the spring of 1975, as an auxiliary to the Back Mountain Jaycees, by a group of women who wished to "embrace" the Jaycees' philosophy of personal development

through leadership and community service.

Their first undertaking was to aid in soliciting for the Back Mountain Library Auction, and to create and man a craft booth whose profits were also contributed to that cause.

To establish a treasury to support their community projects, the Jay-C-Ettes washed cars, held bake sales, sold their hand-painted Christmas or-

naments, and rolled newspaper logs.

Their list of community projects included a children's Halloween party, a family picnic, food basket for a needy family, a Christmas visitation to a senior citizens home, painted fire hydrants in a Bicentennial theme, and placing canisters in the community for the March of Dimes.

They are one of the member groups of the

Back Mountain Bicentennial Council, which is planning a community-wide celebration for the whole area.

As members of the council, the Jay-C-Ettes worked hand-in-hand with the Back Mountain Jaycees, the Back Mountain Cultural Center, the Dallas Junior Women's Club, and other groups.

Future undertakings will be as one of the many participating groups with

the Dallas Fall Fair, and as the sponsors of "Rally 44", a road rally whose profits will be contributed to public broadcasting station WVIA-TV, Channel 44.

At Tuesday night's installation, tribute was paid to the out-going board of directors, which included Glenda Pomrinke, president; Helen Stager, vice-president; Shirley Kishbaugh, secretary; Chris Bachman, treasurer; and advisory board

members, Cathy Schneider, Charlotte Farley, Karen Harworth, and Lois Townsend.
