He is serving as a crewmember aboard the frigate USS Rathburne, homeported at Pearl Harbor, Hawaii. Vice Admiral Robert B. Baldwin, the commander of the U.S. Seventh Fleet,

exercised overall control of the maneuvers from his flagship, the guided missile cruiser USS Oklahoma City. "Readex 1-77", which involved 22 ships and nearly 200 aircraft, was designed to test and enhance the antisubmarine and anti-air warfare preparedness of participating Seventh Fleet units. Myers joined the Navy in September 1969.
