Culvers homeless after trailer fire in Vernon

alarm clock was listed as the probable cause of a fire which destroyed the mobile home of the Phillip Culver family in Vernon last Wednesday night.

The fire was discovered by the Culver's 12-year-old son Michael Wheaton who was home alone with his two-year-old sister at the time. Michael was praised for his quick thinking in getting his sister out of the burning home and safely to a neighbor where assistance was summoned.

The alarm was answered by members of the Franklin and Kunkle Fire departments under the direction of Chiefs Richard Love and Jack Dodson, respectively. More than 40 men responded to the 8 p.m. blaze which was the second structure fire to occur in Northmoreland Township in as many weeks.

Chief Love stated that even though firemen were at the fire hall when the alarm came in and response time was listed at five minutes, they were too late to save any of the family's possessions and the mobile home was declared a total loss.

There were no injuries and Chiefs Love and Dodson reported little difficulty in fighting the fire with the exception of
