receives five dollars to be spent on a treat for the children in the class.

Sue Gusher, hospitality chairman, reported that the PTO will hold its regularly scheduled meeting, Nov. 21, 7:30 p.m. with the program by the second grade. Donuts, tea and coffee will be served.

January. Any parental or teacher comments or ideas will be welcomed.

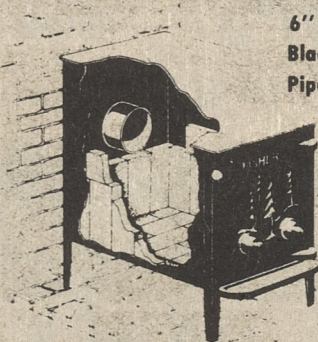
