This was the eighth consecutive year Dr. Kennedy has given European concerts. He is a member of the American Guild of Organists and is Registrar of its local Wilkes-Barre Chapter and is an Associate of the Westminster Choir College in Princeton, N.J.

He has been for the past three years overseas consultant in English, German and Dutch music repertoire for the Boychoir of the Basilica of the Valley of the Fallen, Madrid, Spain.

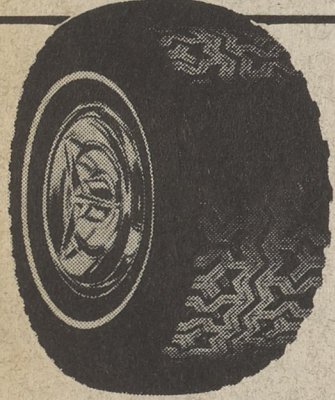

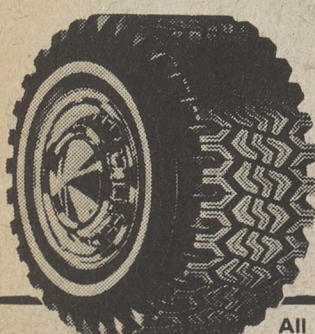
