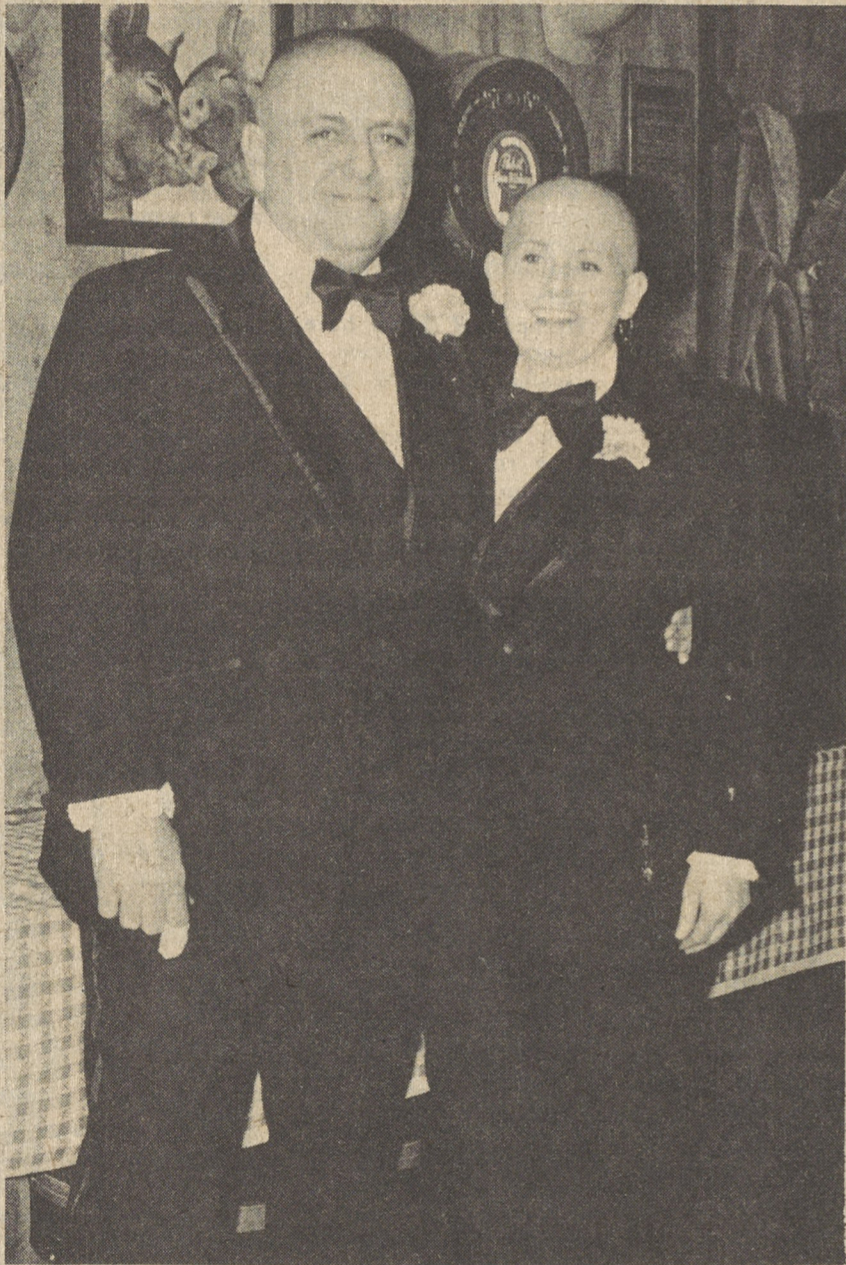
They plan to run a family type bar and restaurant and in the near future will serve hot meals. At the present time, they are serving sandwiches until they purchase and install the necessary equipment.

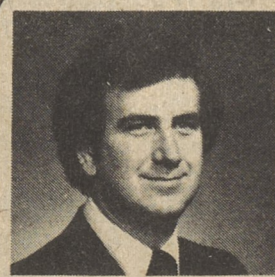
