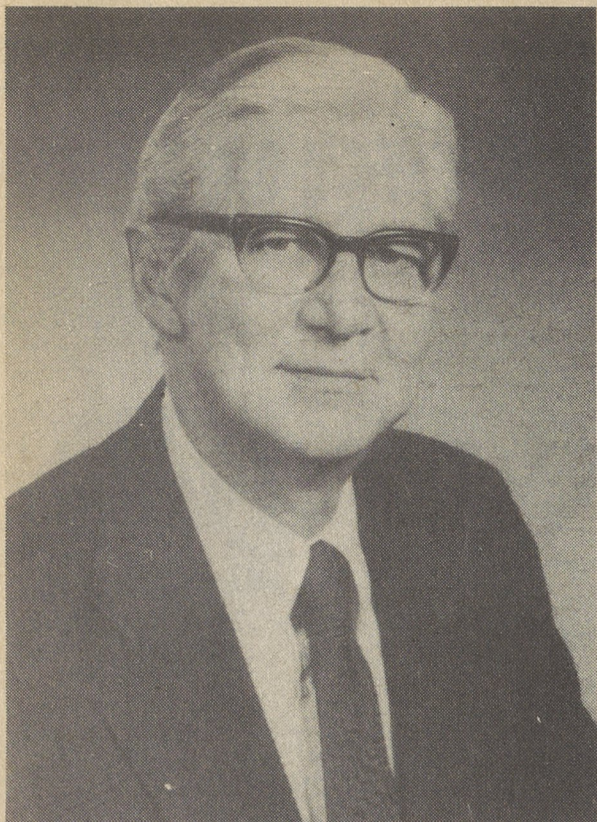

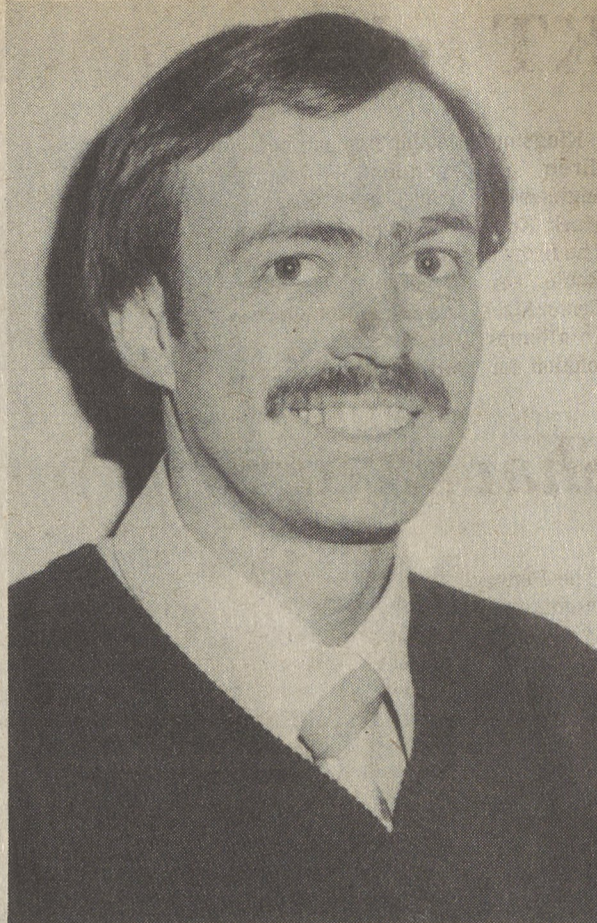
Dr. Weisz will speak on business writing and

analytical reports. She holds a Ph.D. in English from Purdue and a B.A. in English from Hunter College in New York City.

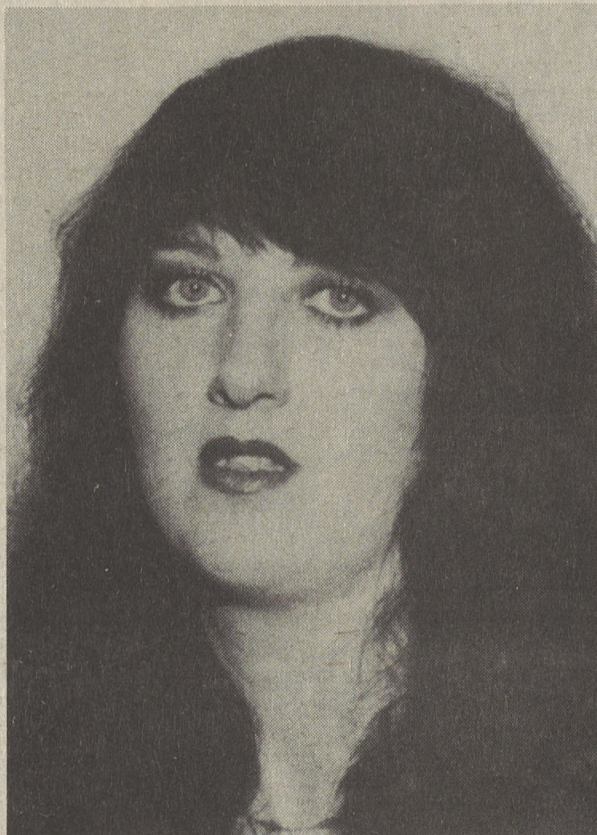
Dr. Weisz teaches report writing and other courses at Penn State Wilkes-Barre Campus.

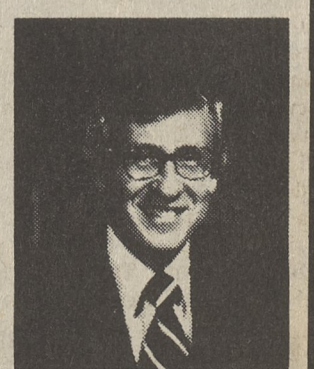

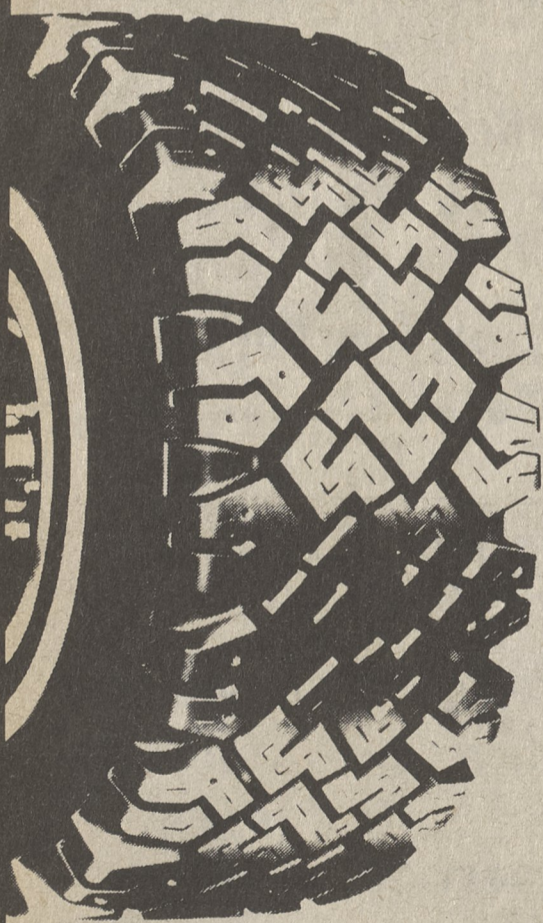
