Luzerne County boasts a rich heritage that is evidenced in numerous sites of historical interest.

Museums that can be visited include the Swetland Homestead, Denison House, Wyoming Historical and Geological Society Museum, 109th Field Artillery Museum and the Wiant Museum. There is an entire village that can be toured at Eckley where the life of the early anthracite miner is portrayed. Locations of museums are listed on page 5 of this publication.

Live Theater in County

Genetti Dinner Theater, located at the Best Western Genetti Motor Lodge on Route 309 in Hazleton is the region's only year-round professional dinner theater. It has become renowned in Northeastern Pennsylvania and attracts people from all over.

There are four nearby amusement parks, Angela, near Hazleton; Hanson's, Harveys Lake; Knoebel's Groves, Elysburg and Ghost Town, Moosic; as well as Rickett's Glen and Frances Slocum State Parks and Moon Lake County Park which offer recreation out-of-doors.

Kirby Park and Coal Street Park, Wilkes-Barre offer playgrounds, tennis courts, swimming and play fields.
