b. The premises shall be sold as a whole and not divided or otherwise separated in any manner whatsoever. Conveyance shall be by Quitclaim Deed

c. All bids shall represent the net consideration for such sale. All real estate transfer taxes, assessments and other charges shall be borne exclusively by the successful bidder, and there shall be no apportionment of the same at the time of settlement.

d. The Board of Directors of Dallas School District reserves the unqualifed right and privilege, in its solution, to accept or reject any bid submitted for the purchase of said realty.

e. All sealed bids shall be opened at a regular public meeting of the Board of Directors of the Dallas School District held on August 11th. 1980 at 8:00 o'clock PM (EDST) to be held in the Administration office, Meeting Room, Church Street, Dallas, Pennsylvania

f.
