

Myers case goes back to HL zoning board for reconsideration

| Luzerne County Common Pleas Judge Bernard Podcasy last week deferred a decision on an injunction sought by neighbors who filed suit against Melvin Myers et al of Harvys Lake in a property-use dispute. <br> Podcasy asked that the Harveys Lake zoning hearing board review the case one more time before he ruled. <br> The request for injunctive relief developed when, according to plaintiffs Dr. Mortimer Slavin, Dr. | Norman Wienckowski and others charged that Myers failed to live up to the terms of a special exception granted for his operation of an apartment in his home in a single family residential zone. Myers did not exercise his right to appeal the grant of special exception and is therefore bound by its terms, which means he must hook up his boathouse to the borough's certain boat mooring posts installed | for rental. <br> The case has been pending for more than three years and has involved the borough zoning hearing board in several reconsiderations of the case. Richard Myers, son of Melvin and a co-defendant in the case, is a Republican committeeman in the borough. <br> A spokesman for the plaintiffs indicated that a hearing on the equity suit would be pending even if the immediate injuntive relief is not a warded by Podcasy. |
