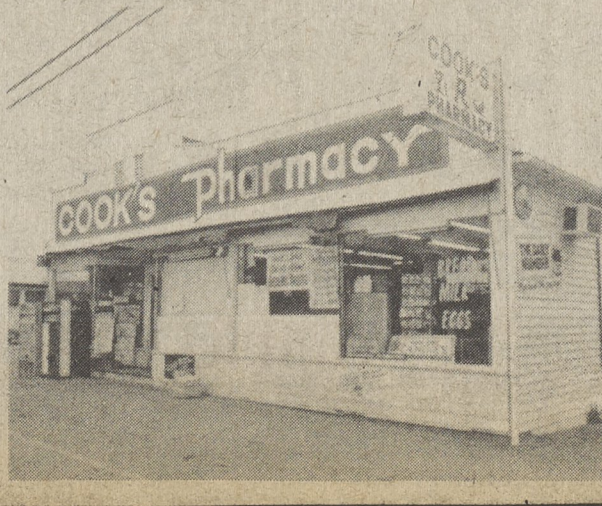
It is a convenient stop to pick up the daily or Sunday papers and as a convenience to Back
