The 35th annual Back Mountain Library Auction will be held July 9 through 12 on the auction grounds behind the library. We have featured in our display case for the next four weeks some of the lovely antique items which will be put up for bids during the auction. There are six unusual Victorian hatpins, a master salt cranberry liner; a turn of the century Oriental handpainted shaving mug; a cloisonne match holder; a blue satin glass rose bowl; a miniature cup and saucer signed from Germany; two handpainted turn of the century Japanese nut dishes; a cut glass salt and pepper set with sterling silver tops; a miner's lite; a cut glass bowl; two brass candle sticks; a slope meter used in the mines; a blue opalescent footed candy dish and four mercury glass tie backs. These items make a beautiful display and we thank Betty and Ernie Ashbridge, antique chairmen of the auction, for allowing us to borrow them for a few weeks.
