Mrs. Dorothe P. Bonita, 76, a resident of Dallas,

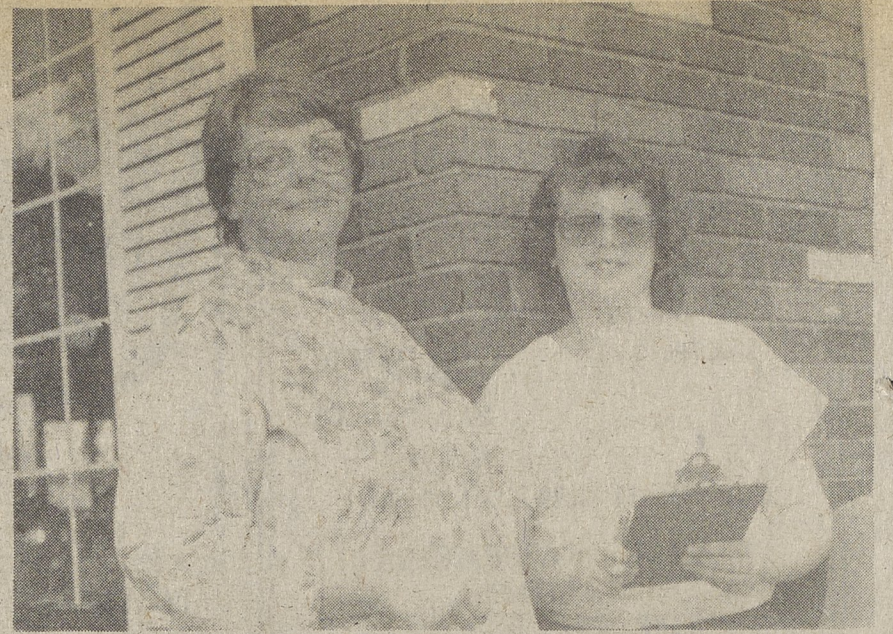
died Wednesday, July 1 in Mercy Hospital.
