Lake-Lehman lists bus routes

Lake-Lehman School District Schools will open classes on the regular time schedule on Tuesday, Sept. 1. Classes for kindergarten pupils will be located in the following elementary schools: Lake-Noxen Elementary Schools; Lehman-Jackson Elementary School; Ross Elementary.

It will be necessary for some pupils to cross boundaries to attend kindergarten classes at a center other than their own geographic area to provide a reasonable pupil-teacher ratio.

Parents who will have children attending schools other than in the Lake-Lehman School District, should have the officials of that school contact the transportation office at Lake-Lehman to make a request or verification for transportation service.

Rt. 1- Start at 7:05 at Stull, 65001 to Noxen Elementary School to Rte. 29. South to Rte. 415 at Harveys Lake via Alderson, Sunset, Idetown. Right on 40060 (Oak Hill), right on Rte. 118 to Lehman Center to 7th and 8th Grade School. Left to Lehman-Jackson Elementary and High School.

Rt. 2- Start at 7:20 at Noxen Methodist Church. Rte. 29, picking up high school students. Go to Noxen Center. Continue on Rte. 29 to Harveys Lake and Rte. 415. Go to Alderson, Sunset and Idetown. Right on 40060 (Oak Hill), right on Rte. 118 to Lehman Center. Left to Lake-Lehman High School.

Rt. 3- Start at 7:30 at Hopfer Bridge. First stop at Lutheran Church, Island Rd., Noxen Methodist Church. Turnaround. Go to Old Noxen Clinic to intersection of Dimick Rd., Barbacci turnaround. Pick up students enroute to Wheeler's Cafe. Go to Rte. 415. Turn right to Lake-Noxen Elementary (40115).

Rt. 4- Start at 7:15 at T710, Warden home. Left on T585 to Brown turnaround, to LaValles. Right on T708; right on 40134; right on 40086; right on 40123; left on T585, Hoover turnaround. Left on 40123 to 7th and 8th Grade School, Lehman-Jackson Elementary, High School.

Rt. 5- Start at 8:03 at Lake-Lehman High School. Rte. 118 to 40060, Oak Hill, (Sunset, Laurel, Pine, Hemlock, Oak Drive), Briarcrest, Rte. 415, Gate of Heaven Elementary School.

Rt. 5.2- Start at 8:03 at Lake-Lehman High School. Go to Rte. 118. Turn right on Rte. 118 to Rte. 415. Dallas Community Church and Gate of Heaven.

Rt. 5.3- Start at 8:03 at Lake-Lehman High School. Right on T795 on Rte. 118. Left on 40060 to Oak Hill (intersection of Oak Drive). Go right on 42nd St., right on Rte. 415 to Rte. 118. To Courtright Ave., left on Cooper St., right on Evans St., left on Courtright St., right on Grove St., left on Pringle St., right on Schuyler Ave., left on Maple St., to Bishop O'Reilly High School and Wyoming Seminary.

Rt. 5.4- Sulton Rd., to Township Line. Turnaround. Left on T611. Left on T795 to Rte. 309 (Fieldcrest, Norris Glen). Turn right to Luzerne. Left on Rte. 11, North to Forty-Fort and Wyoming Seminary Day School.

Rt. 5.6- Start at 8:03 at Lake-Lehman High School. Proceed to Ross Christian Academy, Sweet Valley Lutheran Academy. Rt. 6- Start at 7:40 at intersection of Hilltop and Pine Sts., Oak Hill. Go to Maple St., exit via Sunset. Right on 40060, right on Rte. 118 to 7th and 8th Grade School, Lehman-Jackson Elementary and

High School.

Rt. 7- Start at 7:25 at Lehman Horse Show Grounds, 40060. Left on T177 to Shawanese. Right on 415 to Sunset. Right on 40060 to Idetown Corners and Lehman Horse Show Grounds (118). Cross 118 and continue on 40060 to Huntsville Nursery. Turn right on T795 to Lake-Lehman High School.

Rt. 8- Start at 7:25 at Idetown. Rte. 415. Go to Sunset. Right on Carpenter Rd., 40027. Pick up all high school students and elementary students attending Lehman-Jackson. Go to Scarlet Lake and turnaround. Go left on 40060 (Ridge Ave.); left on Briarcrest Rd., 40050, left on 40060, right on 118 to 7th and 8th Grade School, Lehman-Jackson Elementary, and High School.

Rt. 9- Start at 7:25 at Fieldcrest, T795. Pick up students on Huntsville Rd., Turn right on 40059. Turn right on T712, Kasco turnaround. Return to 40059. Turn left to Chase Corners. Turn left on 40058 to Huntsville Dam. Turn left on T795 to High School, Lehman-Jackson, 7th and 8th Grade School.

Rt. 9.1- Start at 7:25 at Chase Corners. Intersection of 40058 and 40059. Proceed via 40059 to T795. Turn right. Go to Conyngham Farms. Turnaround. Proceed on T795 to Lake-Lehman High School, 7th and 8th Grade School and Lehman-Jackson Elementary.

Rt. 10- Start at 7:25 at the intersection of T795 and T783 (Sulton Rd.) to T671. Turnaround. Return via T683. Turn right on T720 to 40085. Turn left to Huntsville Dam. Turn right to T795, right on 40123 to Lehman-Jackson. Cross 118 and cover T593, Fire House Rd.. Turn right on Rte. 118 to 7th and 8th Grade School, Lehman-Jackson, High School.

Rt. 11- Start at 7:30 at Chase Manor, 40059. Go in the first loop of Chase Manor and exit via T716 to 40059. Go left on 40058, left on T795. Right on T700 to Lake-Lehman High School, Lehman-Jackson Elementary and 7th and 8th Grade School.

Rt. 12- Start at 7:10 at Jackson Twp. line, T599. Return to 40058. Go right to the intersection of 40136. Turnaround at Church. Return to 40058. Pick up all students from Chase Corners on 40058 to Follies Rd., left on T795, right on T700 to High School, Lehman-Jackson Elementary, 7th and 8th Grade School.

Rt. 13- Start at 7:10 on Rte. 29 (Hickory Grove). Left on 40059, left on 40058 to Huntsville Dam. Left on T795, right on 40123 to Lehman-Jackson Elementary, High School, 7th and 8th Grade School.

Rt. 14- Start at 7:15 at the intersection of 40042 and 415, Sandy Beach. Left on 40107, right on 40135 to Dragon turnaround. Right on 40063. Church turnaround. Return to Lake-Noxen Elementary. Continue to 415. Turn left to Picnic Grds., Alderson, Warden Place. Turn left on 40101. Right on 40106 to Sunset. Left on 415 to Idetown. Turn right on 40060 to 118, 7th and 8th Grade Bldg., Lehman-Jackson, High School.

Rt. 14.1- Start at 7:15 at the intersection of T779 and 40115 (Payne's Store, Loyalville). Left on 40123 to Dog House. Outlet. Turn right on 415 to Sunset. Turnaround. Return via 415 to 40123 (Outlet Rd.) and 7th and 8th Grade School, High School, Lehman-Jackson Elementary.

Rt. 14.2- Start at 7:20 on Rte. 29 (Simons Junk Yard). Turn right on 415 to Sandy Beach, Point Breeze, and Sunset. Right on 415 to Oak Hill, 40060 to 118. Turn right on 118 to 7th and 8th Grade School, High School, Lehman-Jackson Elementary.

Rt. 14.3- Start at 7:05 on Rte. 415 at the Dog House. Left on 415 to Sunset (DeVeronica's Store). Right on T711 to Idetown Corners. Cross 415 to Ridge Ave., 40060. Left on Carpenter Rd., 40027. Right on 415. Pick up all elementary students to the intersection of Hanson's Park. Proceed on 415, turn right on 40115 to Lake-Noxen Elementary School.

Rt. 14.4- Start at 7:15 at intersection of 40086 and 40123 (Outlet Rd.). Go to Dog House. Turn left on 415 to Point Breeze, Sandy Beach, Picnic Grds., Alderson, picking up all elementary students. Turnaround. Return via 415, right on 40115 to Lake-Noxen Elementary School.

Rt. 21- A.M. Start at 7:05 at intersection of Rte. 29 and Dimock Rd. (Twp. Line). Right on T758 (Kupstas Store), Hedden Mrs. Store. Left on T748, left on T117, Evergreen Estates. Left on 29, left on T750, left on 29 to

Kupstas Store. Exchange elementary students for high school (Bus 20). Right on T779, right on 40128 (Brown's Rd.). Right on 29, right on 40107, right on 40135, Dragon turnaround. Return to 40115 and Lake-Noxen Elementary School.

P.M. Start at 2:55 on T784, left on T679, right on T750 to the intersection of T762. Turnaround. On T750, turn right on 29, right on T758, left on T680, left on T750, left on 29, right on T779. Right on 40128 (Brown's Rd., right on 29 and to bus park.)

Rt. 22- Start at 7:15 at intersection of 118 and T708. Right on T581 to 29. Left on 29 to Lake Silkworth. Turnaround. (Jigger Jones). Return via 29 to 118 (Pikes Creek Corners). Turn right to T795, left on T700 to High School, Lehman-Jackson Elementary, 7th and 8th Grade School.

Rt. 22.1- Start at 7:02 at Yekels on Bryan's Rd. (T779). Go to 29 and Kupstas Store. Turn left. Go to 40128, to 40115. Turn right. Go to 40065, left to T779, right to 118. Left to T708, left to 40134. Right to T710, left to 40123. Right to (Outlet Rd.) to 7th and 8th Grade School, Lehman-Jackson Elementary, High School.

Rt. 22.2- A.M. Start at 7:00 at Lake-Ross Twp. line, Rte's 40067 and T676. Go to 40061, Pall's Rd.. Turn left to Lake's turnaround. Return to T540. Left to T508. Right on 40069, left on 40068, right on T682, Sylvan Lake Turnaround. Right on 40068, right on T658, right on 40067, right on T684 and Ross Elementary.

A.M. Leave at 7:30 from Ross Elem. via 40067. Right on T676, left on 29, left on T706 to 40067. Turn right to 118 and High School, 7th and 8th Grade Building, High School.

P.M. Leave at 2:10 from Ross Elem. Right on T684, left on 40047, left on T658, left on 40068, left on T682. Lake Silkworth turnaround. Left on 40068, left on 40069, left on T508. Continue on T540, right on 40061 to Lake's turnaround. Return to 40061 to Lake's turnaround. Return to 40061 and 40067. Right to High School for pickup.

P.M. Leave at 3:00 from high school on Rte. 118. Left on T706, right on 29. Right on T676, left on 40067, left on 40061, Lake turnaround. Left on T540 to T508, right on 40068. Left on 40069, right on T682. Turnaround. Right on 40068, right on T658, right on 40067 and Ross Elementary.

Rt. 15- Start at 7:10 at Lake Silkworth (Jigger Jones), Rte. 29 and T717, left on T579. turnaround. Left to Burke's Development. Make loop. Turn right to Texaco Station on 29. Go left. Right on T682. Turn left to 40071 (Moon Lake Rd.). Turn right on 29. Left on 40066 to 118. Right on T795 to High School, Lehman-Jackson Elementary, 7th and 8th Grade School.

Rt. 16- Start at 7:30 at the intersection of T795 and 40060. Continue on 40060 to Town and Country Manor. Make loop. Right on T700. Cross intersection to T795. Right to Lake-Lehman High School, Lehman-Jackson Elementary, 7th and 8th Grade School.

Rt. 17- Start at 7:18 at the intersection of T403 and T702. Go right on 40060. Right on 1122 (Follies Rd.) to Huntsville Dam. Left on T795. Proceed to High School, Lehman-Jackson Elementary, 7th and 8th Grade School.

Rt. 18- Start at 7:20 at Stolarick's Garage, Lehman. West on 118 to T779. Left on 40065 (Kocher Rd.) to 29. Left on 29 to the intersection of 118. Right on 118. Left on 40067, Sweet Valley Rd.. Left on 40061, Pall Rd.. Right on T540. Respen Post. Turnaround. Right on 40061 to Mitchell turnaround. Right on 40067. Left on T748, cross 118, right on 177, right on 29, right on T706 (Gordon Lane). Turnaround. Return and go left on Rte. 29. Right on 40128 (Brown Rd.) to Loyalville (Payne's Store). Go left on 40115 (Bear Hollow Rd.). Left on 40063 to Ony's Corners. Right on 40115 to Lake-Noxen Elementary School.

Rt. 19- Start at 7:25 at Stull. Pick up all elementary students returning to Noxen and Rte. 29. Left on Dimock Rd., left on 29. Go to 415. Turn right and go to 40062, turn right. Left on 40107. Left on 40115 to Lake-Noxen Elementary School.

Rt. 20- A.M. Start at 7:10 at intersection of Rte. 29 and 415. Go to intersection of T679. Turn right on T750 to T762. Turnaround. Return to T750, turn right on 29 (Kupstas Store), exchange with Bus 21 (elementary students for high school students). Right on T706,

recreation facility built on the twenty-five acres of land purchased by the Association for a permanent Fair grounds location.

The Fair provides five days of live entertainment, amusement rides, commercial exhibitors displaying their wares, an opportunity for the community to enter their crafts for judging and prizes, and a variety of delicious foods.

The Fair is located on Rte. 118, Dallas-Lehman, fifteen minutes from Wilkes-Barre.

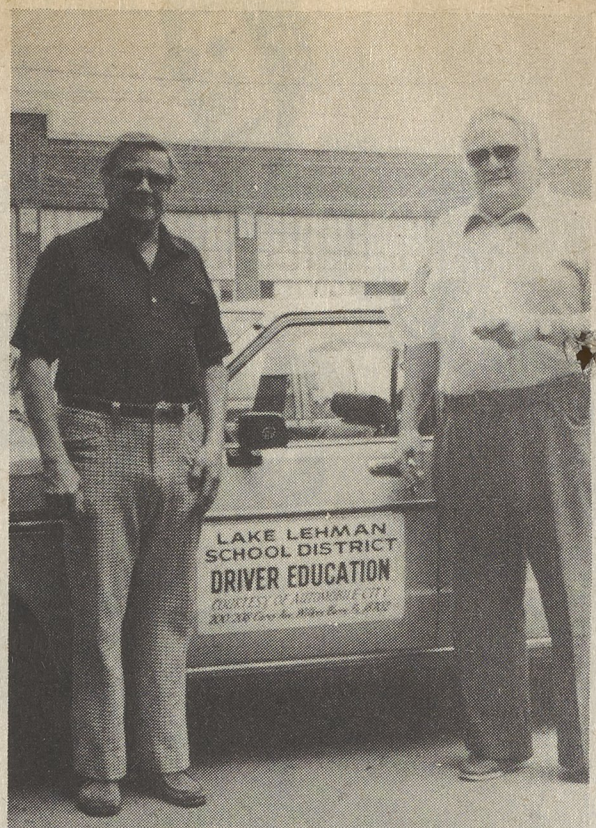
ology and Principles of Sociology.
