The Oneonta Hotel was opened in April, 1898 on the site of the Lake Grove House, which was torn down the previous year. A four story wood and brick structure, the Oneonta burned down on Feb. 2, 1919. At the time of the fire it was owned by James Polland Sr., who had died a few weeks earlier. The cause of the fire was unknown. The Oneonta Dance Pavillion was later built on the site, and it too burned down, in 1928.
