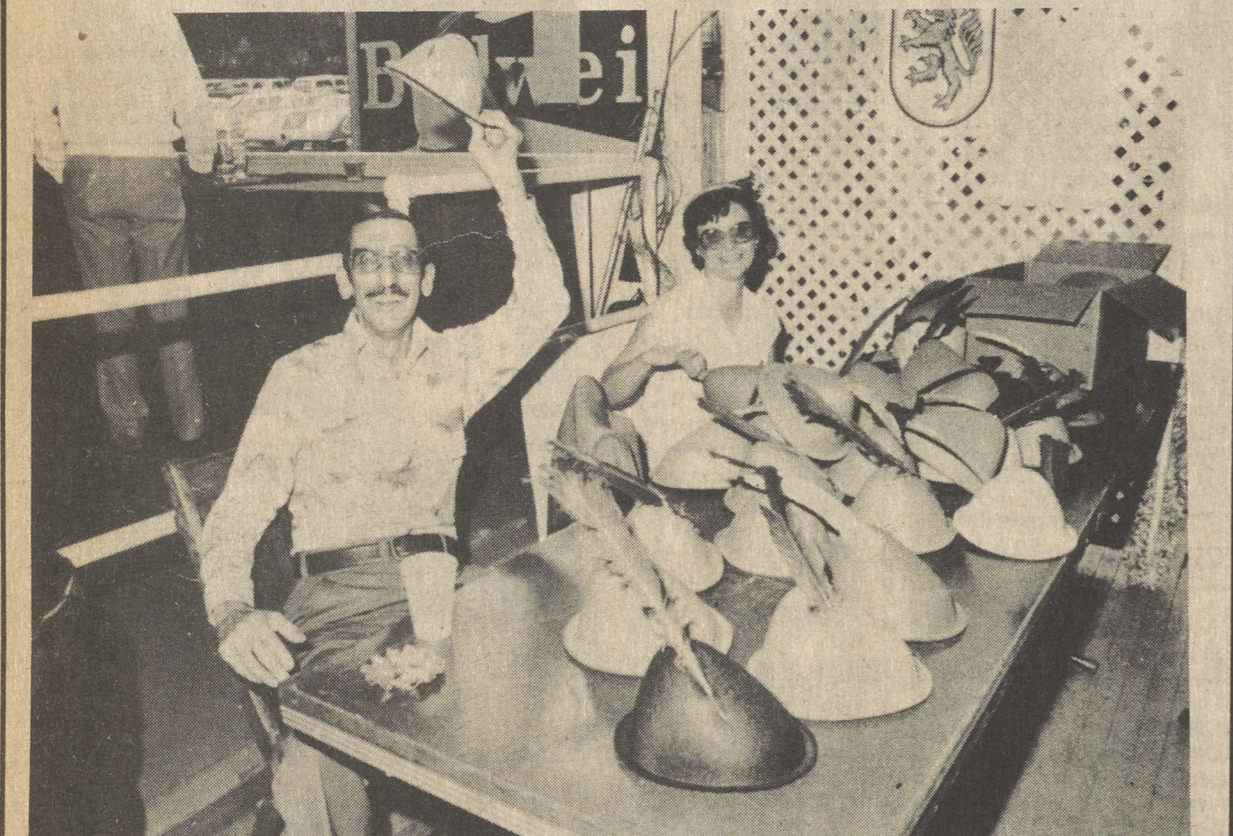


## "German Night" at Irem Country Club

## Dallas School lists bus routes

Route 1--Secondary--Orange to Lake Louise to Orange to Dymond Hollow to James' Nursery, Demunds Corners to Applewood Manor to junior and senior high school; Elementary--Orange to Lake Louise to Orange to Dymond Hollow to James' Nursery, Demunds Corner to Applewood Manor to Intermediate school and Dallas Township.

Route 2--Secondary--Orange to Culver Hill to Eaton's Corners to Moore's Store to Fernbrook to the junior and senior high; Elementary--Orange to Culver Hill to Eaton's Corners to Moore's Store to Intermediate and Dallas Township.

Route 3--Secondary--Carverton to Lewis Corners via Memorial Shrine to Carverton to Slickler Road, Carverton Heights to Moore's Store to Hildebrandt Road to junior and senior high; Elementary--Krispin Road to Mt. Olivet Road to Slickler Road to 8th St.--left to Memorial Shrine to Lewis Corner's down Bodle Road to Grange Hall right to Carverton Heights to East Dallas Road to Hayes Corners to Harris Hill to Trucksville and Westmoreland Elementary.

Route 4--Secondary--Carverton to Lewis Corners via Bodle Road to Carverton to Saxe's Corners via Carverton Road to Trucksville via Route 309 to junior and senior high; Elementary--Carverton to Lewis Corners via Bodle Road to Carverton Road to Trucksville Elementary to Westmoreland and Intermediate.

Route 5--Secondary--Bunker Hill to Meadowcrest through Meadowcrest to Carverton Road to Trucksville via Route 309 to junior and senior high; Elementary--Bunker Hill to Meadowcrest thru Meadowcrest to Carverton Road to Trucksville Elementary to Westmoreland and Intermediate.

Route 6--Secondary--Kunkle to Alderson to Ellsworth's Hill to Kunkle to the Wyoming County line via Route 92 to Kunkle via Route 309 to the junior and senior high; Elementary--Kunkle to Alderson to Kunkle to Ellsworth Hill to Kunkle via 309 to Dallas Township and Intermediate.

Route 7--Secondary--Kunkle to Lake Capitala to Demunds to Fernbrook to junior and senior high; Elementary--Kunkle to the Wyoming County line via Old Route 92 to Kunkle via Route 309 to Lake Capitala to Demunds Corners, Whitesell's Trailer Park, to Dallas Intermediate; Dallas Township, and Dallas Borough Elem.

Route 8--Secondary--Cairn's Store to Trucksville via Route 309 to Lutheran Church to junior high; Elementary--West Dallas to Hayes Corners, Old Lake Road, Whitesell Brothers, Castle Inn, 42nd St., Country Club Road to Dallas Elementary, Dallas Township Elementary and Intermediate. Starting at Fernbrook Corners, up East Overbrook Ave. to Pioneer Ave. to Trucksville and Westmoreland Elementary. (Home trip will be by Bus No. 17) Elementary p.m.--Westmoreland to Shavertown via Center Street, over Wood, Franklin, Beech to Fernbrook to Roushey Plot.

Route 9--Secondary--Upper Demunds to Applewood Manor to Demunds Road to Whitesell's Trailer Park via Hildebrandt Road to junior high and senior high.

Route 10--Secondary--Newberry Estate via Pioneer Ave. to Trucksville via Route 309 to junior high and senior high.

Route 11--Secondary--Mark II, Fernbrook via Overbrook Ave., to Huntsville Dam, down Huntsville Road to Gate of Heaven and junior high and senior high; Elementary--Mark II to Fernbrook to W. Overbrook Ave., to Huntsville Dam, to Dallas Elementary, Dallas Township and Intermediate; starting again at Parker Fuel, up Beech St., to Goeringer Hill, down Center St., to Westmoreland.

Route 12--Secondary--Trucksville via Pioneer Ave. to senior high; Elementary--Parrish Heights to Dallas Borough Elementary, Dallas Township Elementary and Dallas Intermediate; Elementary--Conyngnam Ave. through New Goss Manor to Dallas Township and Intermediate.

Route 13--Secondary--Starting at Krispin Hill to Midway Manor to junior and senior high; Elementary--Meadowcrest to Trucksville Gardens to Trucksville to Pioneer Avenue and Intermediate.

Route 14--Secondary--Fernbrook to Pioneer Ave., to Harris Hill Rd. Lehigh St. to junior high.

Route 15--Secondary--Trucksville Gardens to Trucksville to senior high; Elementary--Midway Manor to Brown Manor to Checkerboard to Trucksville, Westmoreland and on to Intermediate and Dallas Township.

Route 16--Secondary--West Dallas to junior high and senior high; Elementary--Route 309, to crest to Dallas Elementary and Intermediate, Elementary P.M.--Intermediate to Dallas Elementary to Huntsville Dam and West Overbrook to Pioneer Avenue and West Dallas.

Route 17--Secondary--Midway Manor to Trucksville to Huntsville Road, to senior high.

Route 18--Secondary--Demunds to Fernbrook to Gate of Heaven to senior high.

Route 19--Secondary--Harris Hill Road to Center Street, cross Route 309 to Pioneer Avenue to Dallas to junior and senior high; Elementary--Midway Manor to Moore's Store, to Conyngnam Avenue to Intermediate and Dallas Township; Elementary--East Dallas Church, to Roushey Plot entrance to Fernbrook, to Terrace St. to Westmoreland Elementary School.

Route 20--Secondary--Carverton Road to Shavertown, Pioneer Ave. to Junior and Senior High. Elementary--Midland Drive, to Lake St., to Sterling Ave. to Huntsville Road to Dallas Elementary and Dallas Township Elementary School.

Route 21--Secondary--West Dallas to Macheil Ave. to Sterling Ave. to junior and senior high.

Route 22--Secondary--Shavertown via Lehigh Street to Harris Hill Road to Midway Manor to Checkerboard to Meadowcrest to Gate of Heaven to Senior High to West Side Tech. Elementary--Hall's Drug Store, up Center Street, to Goeringer Hill, to Beech St. and down to Lower Demunds Road to Intermediate; Elementary--Shuttle--Division St., to E. Center St. to Main St., to St. Paul's Church, cross 309 to Ferguson Ave. to Monte's Record Store, to 309 to Lehigh St. and on to Westmoreland Elementary.

Route 23--Secondary--Hillsdale to 309 to Shavertown to Center St., over Wood, Franklin and Beech to Fernbrook to junior and senior high.

Route 24--Secondary--Starting at Noon's Gas Station to College Manor, Haddonfield Hills to Lake St., Gate of Heaven, Parrish Heights and on to junior and senior high school.

Route 25--Secondary--Starts at Towne House in Dallas to Fernbrook Corners to Shavertown, to Carverton Road to Wyoming Seminary Prep School in Kingston.

Route 26--Secondary--Trucksville Pharmacy to Pioneer Ave., to Hupsville Road to junior and senior high school.

Mini Bus--Starting at Bunker Hill, near Francis Slocum Dam, go to top of hill and turn around come back down to Carverton Road, to Route 309, to Uncles Freight to Hillside Farms, down to Route 309, into Trucksville and Westmoreland Schools, and starting at Duke Isaacs, onto Pioneer Ave. and into Mt. Airy Road, back down to Pioneer Ave., Shavertown Methodist Church, and onto Dallas Borough Elementary School, to Intermediate and back down to Westmoreland Elementary. Gate of Heaven--Students ride to school on the regular Dallas buses listed above will be dropped off at the Dallas Junior High School where they will be taken to Gate of Heaven School by Bus No. 10. Other Gate of Heaven buses are as follows directly to Gate of Heaven School.

Bus 11--Huntsville Road, Parrish Heights to Gate of Heaven.

Bus 17--New Goss Manor and Orchard View Terrace to Gate of Heaven.

Bus 22--Lehigh St., to Harris Hill Rd., to Midway Manor, to Meadowcrest to Carverton Rd., to Gate of Heaven.

Bus 24--West Dallas, Haddonfield Hills, Elmcrest and Country Club Road to Gate of Heaven.
