

Nail down beautiful hands for a polished look on the big day!

tant for the final shine.

The grey buff, on the opposite side of the "Satin Buff" stick, gives the nails a final sheen after only a few seconds of stroking.

As the manufacturer suggests repeating this process on a weekly basis to ensure a beautiful shine, as well as to condition the nail surface and

the surrounding cuticles, the prospective bride would be advised to start using "Satin Buff" in advance of the wedding day, so her hands will be at their loveliest when the groom slips the wedding ring on her finger.
