Back Mt. resident arrested on drug charges

Theodore S. Smith, RD 5, Shavertown, 21, was charged Saturday, April 17, with possession with intent to deliver or manufacture LSD and marijuana. He was arraigned before District Justice Robert Marshall, Shickshinny, and released after posting \$1,000 bail.

A preliminary hearing was set for Monday, April 26, at 7 p.m., before District Justice John Hopkins of Edwardsville.

According to police the arrest came from an incident that occurred Jan. 13 at Holiday Market parking lot, West Main Street, Plymouth.

On that morning while patrolling, Officer David

Bonawitz said he saw Smith's car with the dome light on in the parking lot. He said he saw Smith strike a girl who was with him.

Police allegedly noticed an odor of marijuana and Patrolman Lynn Fitser saw a plastic bag containing what appeared to be marijuana under the front seat of Smith's car. They searched the car and found what appeared to be more drugs.

The confiscated material was sent to the state crime lab for analysis.

Officers assisting Bonawitz in the arrest were Plymouth Police Chief John Thomas and Sgt. Larry Karnes.

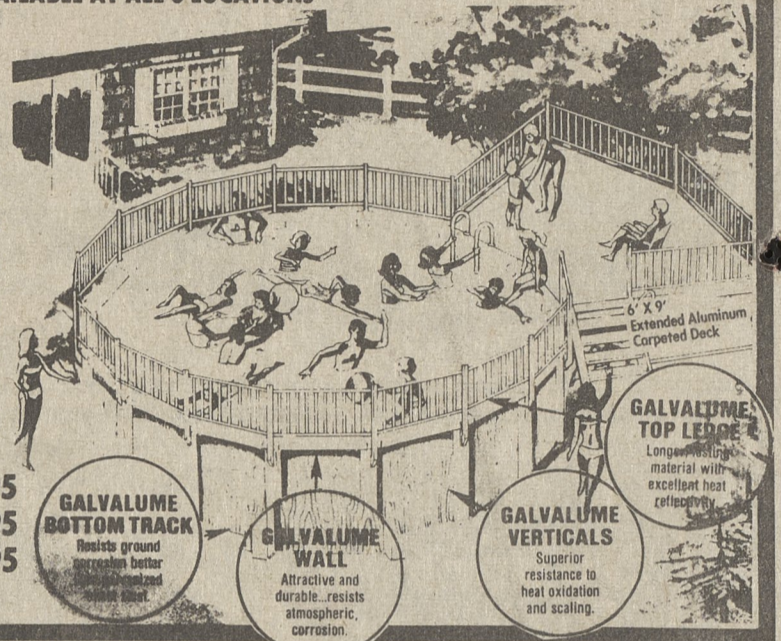

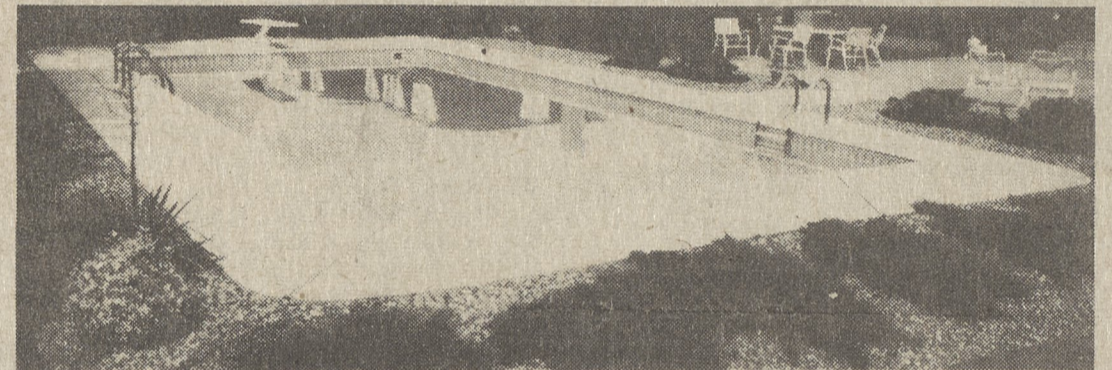
