Lady Mounts trounce Hawks

The Lady Mountaineers held first place in their division last week by defeating Hanover 15-8 behind the strong hitting of Kathy Walsh and Debbie Shone. Both girls drove out long triples and scored three runs each to aid in the Dallas win. Shone had three hits for five times at the plate and Walsh hit two for four.

Banks hit two for three and S. Ciccarelli had two hits.

Chris Dombek was credited with the win striking out two and walking nine.

The win put the Lady Mounts record at 7-1.

The Dallas girls took over first place in the league last Tuesday when they edged Coughlin 6-5 at

the Dallas Little League field.

The Crusaders were leading 5-2 until the bottom of the fifth inning when the Lady Mounts scored four runs. Kim Reese started the fifth inning rally with a single and Kathy Walsh followed with another single. Tammie Sutton drove out a double then Theresa

Baseski and K. Morgan each came through with singles to drive in the runs.

Debbie Shone was credited with the win. She fanned five and walked six going all the way on the mound for Dallas.

Marie Vodzak, who was the winning pitcher against the Dallas girls on Monday was credited with Tuesday's loss.

The Coughlin girls defeated Dallas 10-8 Monday at their field in Miners Mills.

Dallas girls collected 18 hits off Vodzak on Monday but powerful hitting by the Crusaders combined with good defense gave them the 10-8 win.

Bordley leads Dallas thinclads to victory

Norm Bordley picked up four firsts and six of his Mountaineer teammates were double first place winners to lead Dallas in thumping Hanover 116-24 last Wednesday at the Wilkes-Barre Stadium.

The Mountaineers won their first meet to put their record at 1-1. Hanover won only five of the 18 events. Bordley ran anchor for the 400 and 1600 meter winning relay teams, won the 100 meter dash and tied his teammate Tony Tucker for first in the 200 meter dash.

Tucker picked up his second win as a member of the 400 meter relay team with Joe Simon and Kurt Goeringer. Joe Lipo took a first as a member of the 3200 meter relay

team and on the 1600 meter relay team. Bob Richardson took a first as a member of the 3200 meter relay team and another as a leg of the 1600 meter relay team. Tim Guzek collected a first in the 800 meter run and a second one as a member of the 3200 meter relay team. Andy Manusky took a first in the 110 meter high hurdles and a first in the triple jump. Mike Kern placed first in the shot put and in the discus.

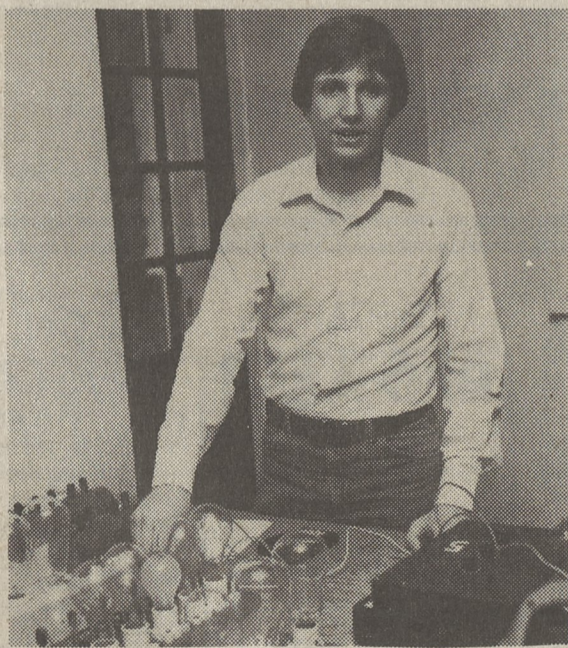
