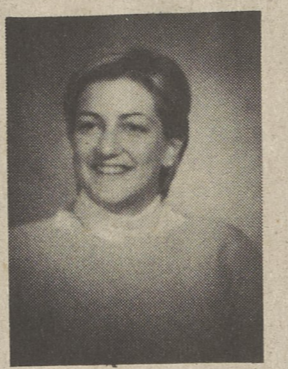

WILLIAM R. MAINWARING was installed as the Greater Wilkes-Barre Chamber of Commerce's Chairman at the 98th Annual Meeting.

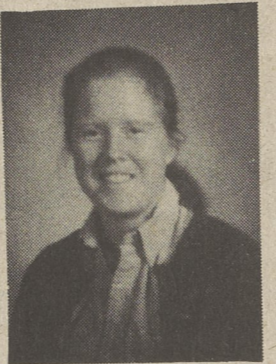

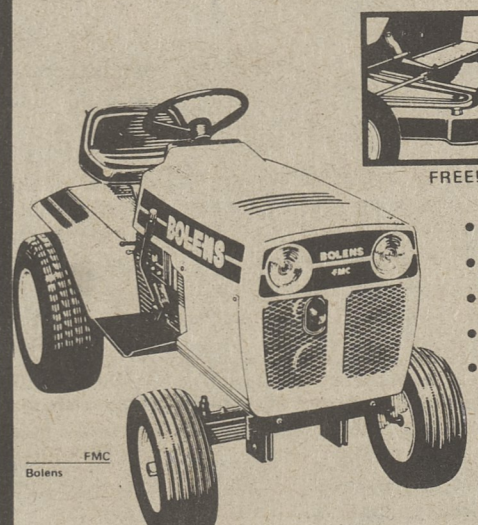
