

Rec Center holds Christmas in July

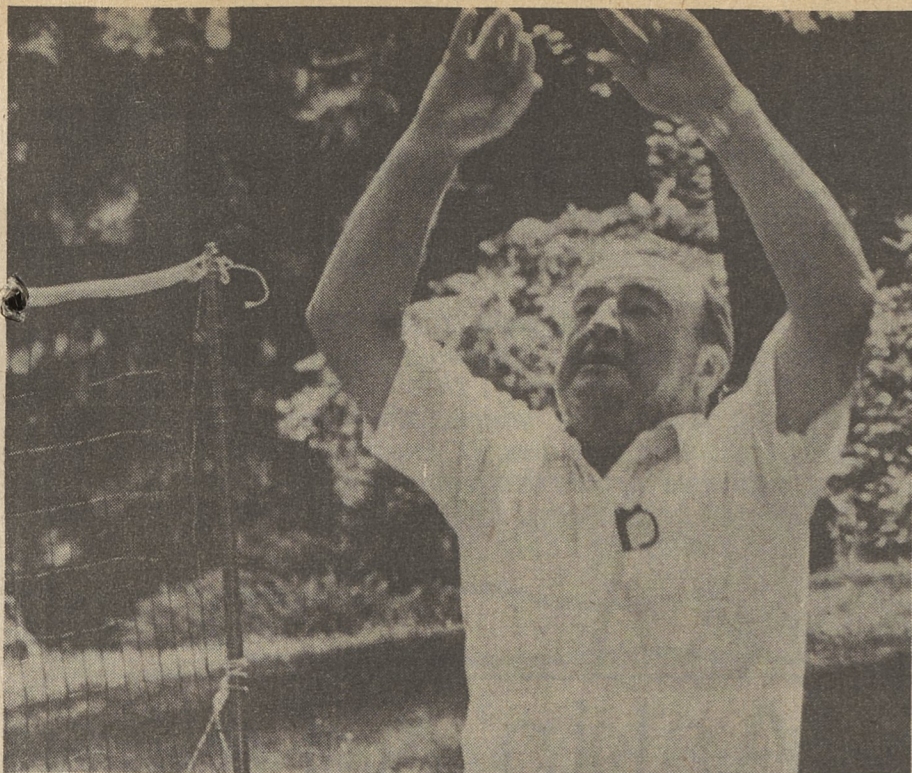
