## Lamoreaux-Farmer's Inn take honors

Lamoreaux Auto Parts captured straight season honors in Division One of the Back Mountain Slo-Pitch Softball League, finishing with a straight season record of 18 wins and four losses, while Farmers Inn, which finished with a straight season record of 13 wins and eight losses, took honors in Division Two.

In Division One, Hearthstone Pub and Pizza Bar tied for second place honors with straight season marks of 17 wins and five losses each. 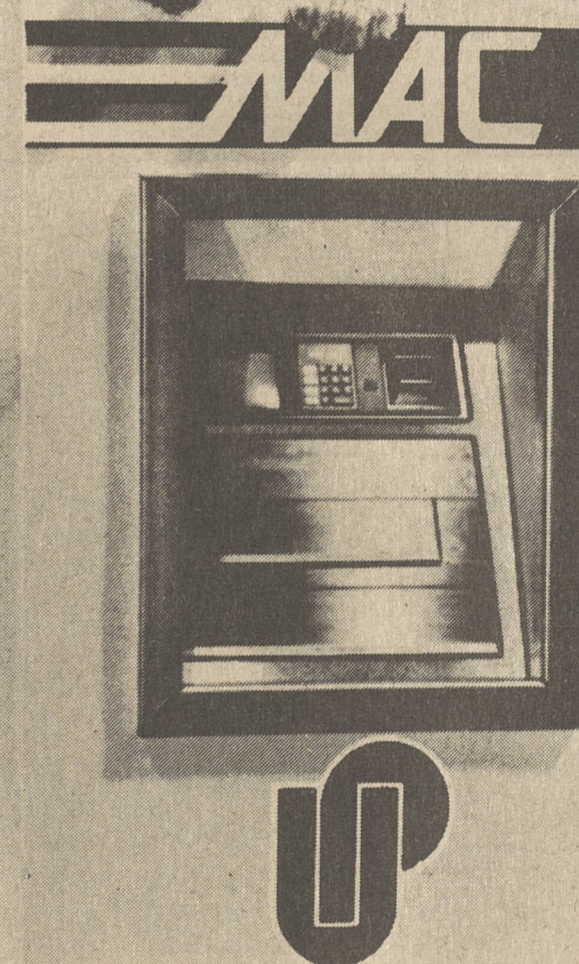
