Back Mountain Youth Soccer kicks off fifth season

Six hundred and thirty two boys and girls from Back Mountain and Wyoming Valley Communities kicked off the Back Mountain Youth Soccer League's fifth season, Saturday, Aug. 28.

The record number of boys and girls, ages 7 to 14, in the program is more

than a 40 percent increase over last year. The league started with 75 youngsters on five teams in one division in 1978. This year there are 40 teams in 4 divisions.

Division I has five teams of 13 and 14 year olds, several of whom will be playing for the fifth

season. Division II consists of 12 teams of 11 and 12 year olds divided into American and National Conferences. Division III's 9 and 10 year olds also play in two conferences of six teams each. Division IV has 11 teams of 7 and 8 year old youngsters.

Division I will play on Tuesdays and Thursdays at the Kingston Township field on East Center Street in Shavertown. Saturday games will be played at Penn State's Lehman campus field. Division II plays every week night at Lake Lehman High School and Saturdays at Kingston Township. College Misericordia is the site for Division III games, both week nights and Saturdays. All Division IV games are played at the Dallas Intermediate field.

Evening games begin at 6 p.m. at all locations. Saturday games start at 9 a.m. and run throughout the day.

George Lister, league commissioner, attributes rapid growth of soccer in the area to the league's emphasis on participation, skill development and fun rather than competition, and explosive growth in the popularity of the sport nationwide. "The recent network prime time broadcast of the World Cup finals to the U.S. is just one example of soccer's growing popularity," Lister noted.

Hockey league looks balanced

Lake-Lehman Girls Hockey Coach Jane Morris and Dallas Hockey Coach Robyn Jones agree that this year's Girls High School Hockey League is better balanced than it has been in past years.

"I wouldn't try to predict which teams would be toughest," said Coach Morris. "All of the teams in the league have developed feeder programs. Most of the schools have experienced players returning. Wyoming Seminary has always been the team to beat but this year appears to be entirely different. Jones agreed with Miss Morris. "With the extended league schedule, this year there will be a true league champion. Each school plays its opponents twice so there will be no more 'trust to luck' champions. The teams will have their work cut out for them."

Morris has all but one of last year's starters returning. The nucleus of the team are un-

derclassmen. She has one senior, 10 juniors, 14 sophomores and four freshmen. Six of her team members attended the International Hockey Camp in Maryland and all of them attended the Back Mountain Sports Camp. Sue Bonsavage was named Best Defensive Player at the International Camp and she and Kim Fey were named to the camp's All Star team.

Rebecca Clifford is a new member of the team this season but Miss Morris said that she is showing tremendous potential at goalie position. Freshman Kelly Wandel is also looking promising, according to Morris.

"Last year was a

rebuilding year for us," said Morris. "This year we will field a much more experienced team. I am very pleased with the cooperation of my assistant, Pat Jachimowicz."

At Dallas, Jones has all of last year's starters returning.

Cathy Helgemo is at goal keeper for the first time but Jones said she is showing great potential. Senior Lori Evans is starting goal keeper. Jones is relying heavily on Robin Pawling to lead the scoring and Betsy Snyder for defense. "She has the best stick," said Jones. "This is her third year as letterman. Junior Cristi Strauser, at Link, is our playmaker. She is great going both ways."

Ten of the Dallas players attended the U.S. Olympic Development Camp at Stroudsburg. Strauser was chosen to attend the Lafayette Camp for a week and was selected as first alternate to the Keystone Games. "We're looking for a good season but it's going to be tough," said Jones.
