Do not peel squash. Cut into large pieces, seed. Place all ingredients except milk in a large saucepan. Bring to a boil and then reduce heat to a simmer for 45 minutes-1 hour, or until vegetables are soft. Strain and save stock. Scoop out squash pulp and blend with cooked onion in a blender.

Mix puree with remaining

stock and heat. Finish with the addition of milk or -cream and adjust seasoning over simmering temperature. Serve. SALMON QUICHE 11/4 c. flour (preferable

whole wheat) 1/4 t. salt ½ c. butter 1/4 c. cold water 1 egg white

Combine flour and salt.

Cut in butter with pastry blender until mixture resembles course crumbs. Gradually add water and mix with a fork until blended. Line a quiche pan or 9-inch pie plate with pastry. Brush with egg white.

1 c. canned salmon ½ c. chopped onion 11/4 c. shredded Swiss or Gruyere cheese, 5 oz. 4 eggs, slightly beaten 1 pt. half 'n half dash salt dash black pepper dash cayenne

2 T. chopped parsley

Combine salmon, onion and cheese. Place in crust. Combine eggs, half 'n half, salt, pepper, and cayenne; pour over cheese mixture. Sprinkle with parsley. Bake at 375


