In other matters, Monroe Township supervisors retained Atty. John Morgan as township solicitor, and renamed Mrs. Arlene Traver as township secretary-treasurer. Carlton Shupp was appointed sewage inspector at a rate for property owners of \$30 per inspection, plus 17 cents per mile for the use of his car in traveling to and from inspections.

Regular meetings of Monroe Township board of supervisors will be held the first Monday evening of each month at 7:30 at the home of the board's secretary-treasurer, except for the months of July and September when the meetings will be held the first Tuesday evening at 7:30 of those two months because of the 4th of July and Labor Day observances, which fall on Mondays.

Monroe Township supervisors adopted the 1983 budget for the township and retained the tax levy at 10 mills. The budget included Revenue Sharing funds and can be inspected by appointed at the office of the secretary-treasurer, Mrs. Arlene Traver.
