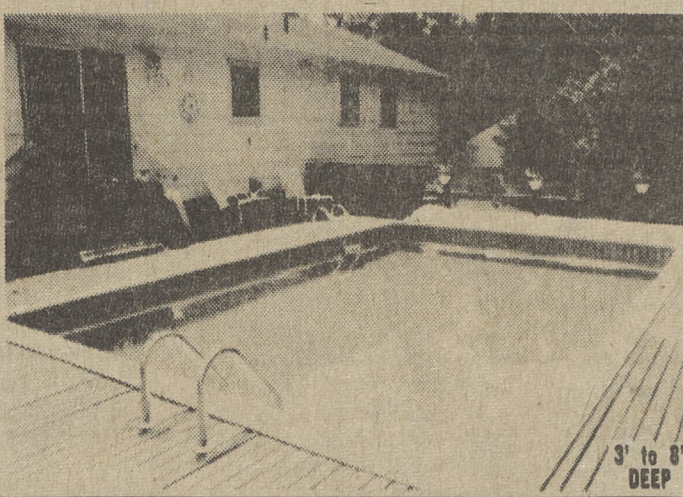

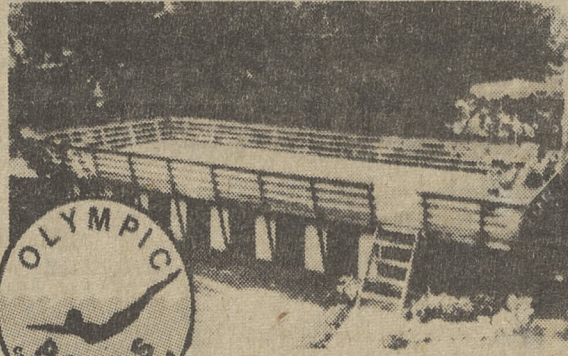

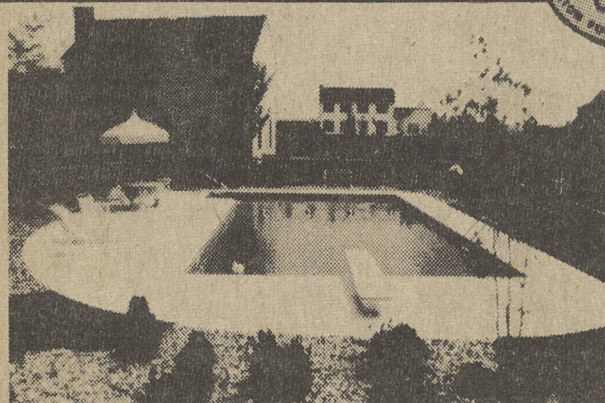

## Kindergarten Registration

The following policy on admission of beginners has been adopted by the Lake-Lehman School Board:

Kindergarten - Children who have reached the age of 5 by Sept. 30, 1983, will be admitted to the kindergarten program.

First grade - Children who have reached the age of 6 by Sept. 30, 1983, will be admitted to first grade.

All-Day Kindergarten - Kindergarten in the Lake-Lehman School District is an all-day program.

Registration and screening for kindergarten and first grade students will be held in the area according to the following alphabetical schedule of last names:

Lehman-Jackson Building, Lehman, Monday, April 25 - 9 a.m., (A,B); 10 a.m., (C,D,E,F); 11 a.m., (G,H,I); 1 p.m. (J,L); 2 p.m., (M).

Tuesday, April 26 - 9 a.m., (N,O,P); 10 a.m., (Q,R); 11 a.m., (S); 1 p.m., (T,U,V); 2 p.m., (W,X,Y,Z).

Lake-Noxen Building, Harveys Lake, Wednesday, April 27 - 9 a.m., (A,B); 10 a.m., (C,D,E,F); 11 a.m., (G,H,I); 1 p.m., (J,K,L); 2 p.m., (M).

Thursday, April 28 - 9 a.m., (N,O,P); 10 a.m., (Q,R); 11 a.m., (S); 1 p.m., (T,U,V); 2 p.m., (W,X,Y,Z).

Ross Building, Sweet Valley, Friday, April 29 - 8:30 a.m., (A,B,C); 9:30 a.m., (D,E,F,G); 10:30 a.m., (H,I,J,K); 12:30 p.m., (L,M,N,O,P); 1:30 p.m., (Q,R,S,T,U,V,W,X,Y,Z).

If you are unable to

register your child on the dates listed above, you may also register in the elementary office in the Lehman-Jackson Elementary Building, Lehman or the Lake-Noxen Elementary Building, Harveys Lake. The offices will be open every weekday between 8 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Please remember this is one school district and the administration and board of directors reserve the right to assign children to different buildings. In order to maintain reasonable sized classrooms, it may be necessary to transfer children to another building within the district. Transportation would be furnished.

This year a pre-kindergarten survey clinic will be conducted at the same time as registration. The evaluation will consist of screening in hearing, speech, vision, motor perception and coordination and kindergarten readiness assessment.

School officials must review a child's immunization record. Parents are asked to bring all necessary immunization records to school at the time of registration. No child will be admitted in the Lake-Lehman School District until proof of immunization is presented to the school nurses.

Before entering school, state law requires the following immunizations: three diphtheria, three tetanus, three trivalent oral polio vaccine, one measles, one rubella and one mumps.
