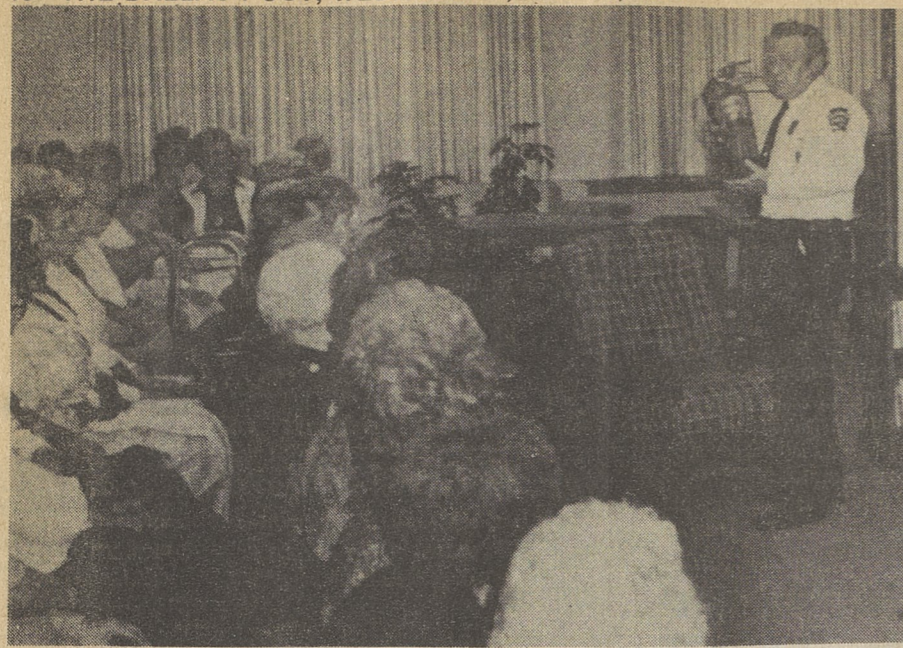


Noxen Area Notes
