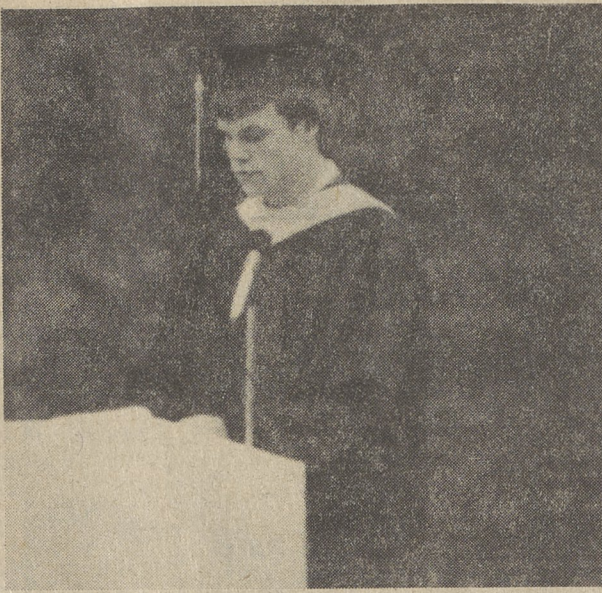

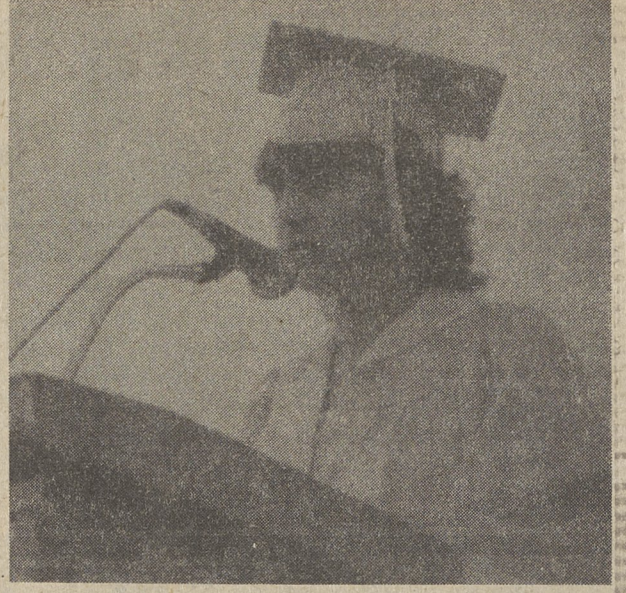

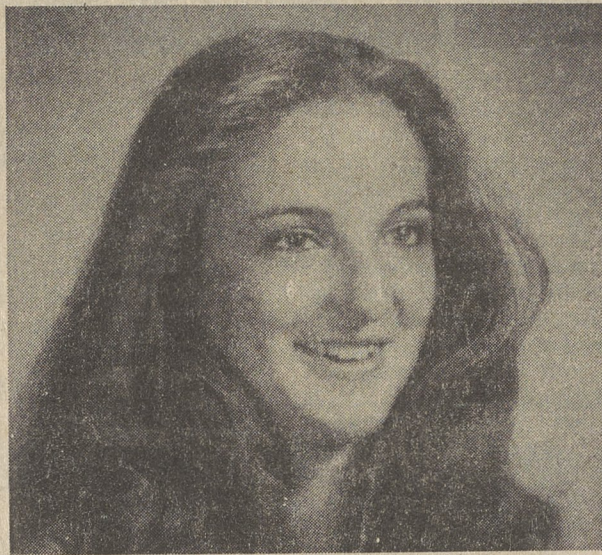

## Aides Are Honored

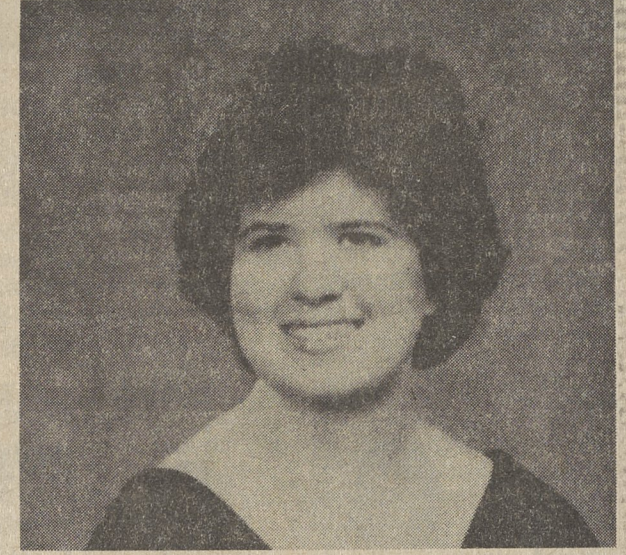

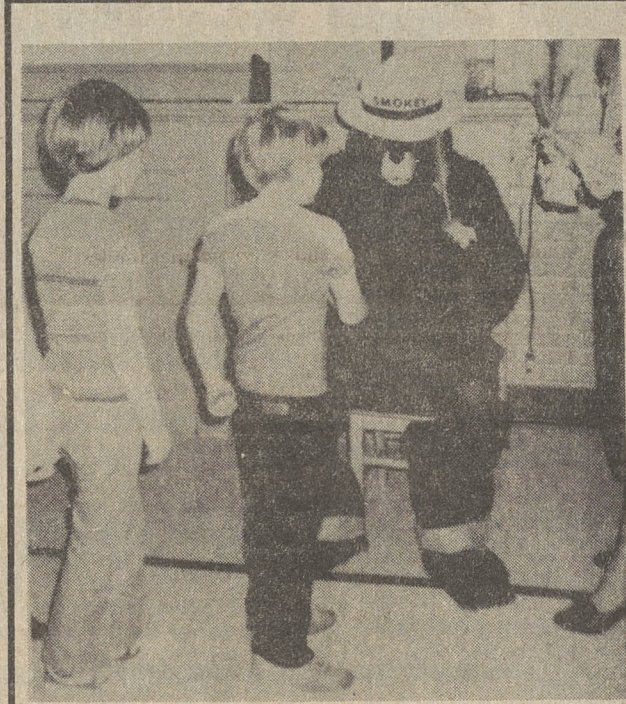
