Funeral was held from the Curtis L. Swanson Funeral Home, Pikes Creek. Interment was in Kocher Cemetery, Ruggles.

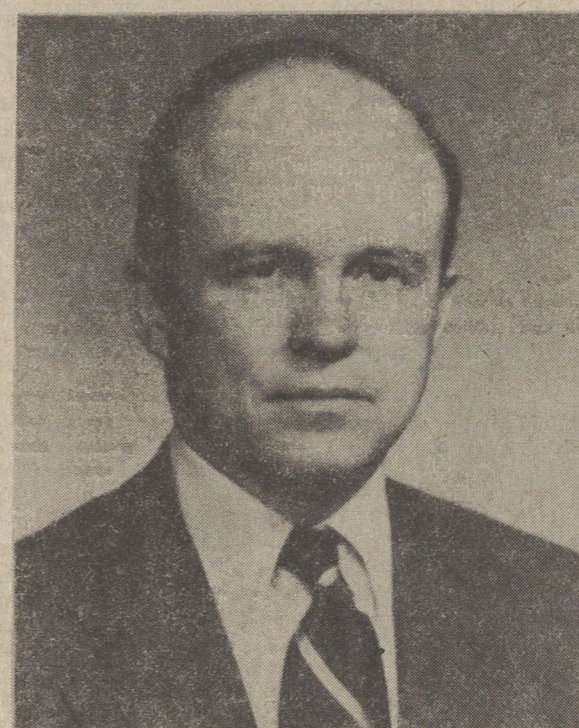
HELEN WAZETER
