## LCCC Adds Computer Courses

Everyone realizes the importance of computer literacy in this day and age and to help keep up with the changing times and the needs of the upcoming college students, Luzerne County Community College has added to its approximately 53 one and two-year programs of study a new two-year associate in science degree program in Computer Science.

Designed for students planning to transfer to a four-year degree program in computer science, the program is being offered for the first time in the Fall 1983 semester.

Besides the English, history, speech, science and social science course requirements, the program will deal heavily in the math and computer science area.

Among the math courses required for the program are Calculus I, II and III and Differential Equations. Computer courses to be offered include Intro-

duction to Computer Science, COBOL Programming I and II, and FORTRAN Programming I and II.

Introduction to Computer Science is a first course of study in general computer science. Topics discussed in this course include fundamental computation concepts, algorithms, flowcharting and programming. BASIC coding, characteristics of computers, organization of computer systems, and computer applications in science and business.

Trends, projections and the impact of computers on society are also discussed.
