On Wednesday, July 13, 1983, the Kingston Township Board of Supervisors passed the following ordinance: KINGSTON TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 1983 - 5

An ordinance further amending the zoning ordinance of Kingston Township, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania. To increase certain fees for zoning permits and building permits for construction of new buildings and structures of whatever nature and for whatever purpose. The ordinance further provides for the following fee schedule:

a. The fees for all zoning permits for all buildings and structural improvements to existing structures, including but not limited to, all repairs, roofing, and siding, but excluding interior remodeling, shall be as follows:

(i) First One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars of declared costs of job - no fee required.

(iii) One Hundred One (\$101.00) Dollaring of declared costs of job - no fee

required.

(ii) One Hundred One (\$101.00) Dollars to One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars for declared cost of job - Two (\$2.00) Dollars.

(iii) Over One Thousand Dollars of declared cost of job-Two (\$2.00) Dollars per each One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars increment of cost of job.
