## Local governments receive assistance

County and municipal governments can find assistance in supporting local non-profit arts organizations in their areas through the Local Government Program of the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts, a state agency under the direction of Governor Dick Thornburgh.

All local governments are urged to apply to the program which provides matching grants, maximum of \$5,000 to governments that set aside an appropriation in their 1984 budget to support the arts in their communities.

According to Local Arts Services Program Director Karen Pollock, local governments need not have passed their 1984 budgets to apply by the Oct. 1, 1983 grants deadline. Application is only an indication of intent to support the arts, and grants will be awarded contingent upon the appropriation made by local government funds for this purpose, Pollock explained.

This year, restrictions on matching requirements for grants have been lessened. First-time applicants initiating a program of arts support, and applicants increasing support will be given priority consideration.

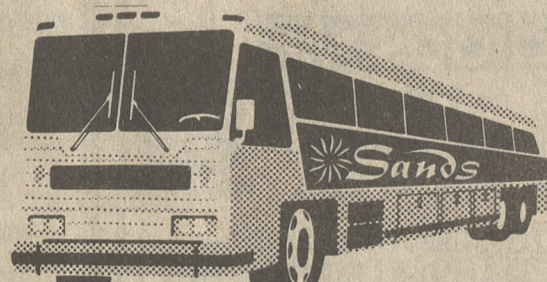
