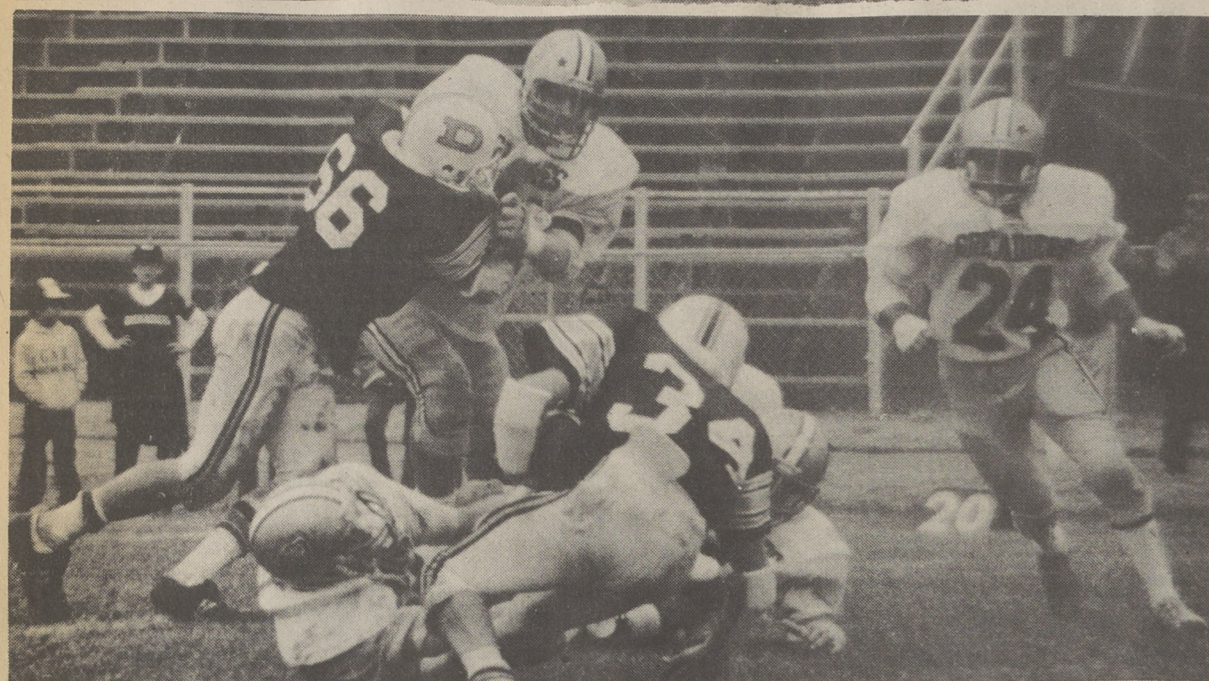

## Dallas gets first win over GAR in nine years

Dallas' triumph over GAR Saturday snapped a nine-year losing streak to the Grenadiers. Coach Ron Rybak's charges only scored seven points, but had numerous other scoring opportunities but failed to cash in on them.

"I wasn't pleased with our offense. We moved the ball effectively between the 20s, but when we got in close we just didn't make the plays necessary to put them away," Rybak said.

This was the 17th meeting between the two teams with GAR still holding a commanding edge of 12 wins to five for the Big D lads.

"There is a great deal for young children to learn, but it is amazing how quickly they pick it up," said

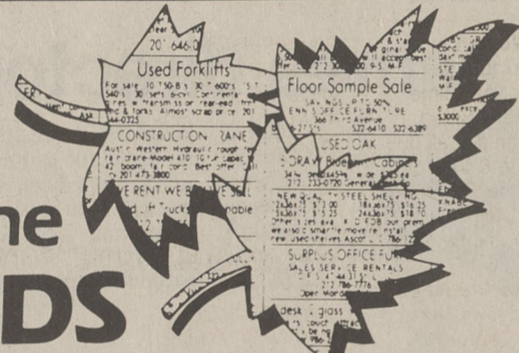
Bob Shotwell, president, Back Mountain Junior Football Club.
